To All Interested Licensees,

In further response to actions taken by Governor Stitt as well as local officials to the Covid-19 pandemic, wherein some on-premise retail establishments such as bars and restaurants have been ordered to close for various periods, the Oklahoma ABLE Commission provides the following guidance, together with previous direction in an effort to aid affected licensees.

- 1. Any licensed wine and spirit wholesaler, beer distributor, small brewer self-distributor, small winery self-distributor, or any other licensee authorized to distribute alcoholic beverages in this State may continue to sell and deliver alcoholic beverages to any mixed beverage, caterer mixed beverage combination, or on-premise beer and wine licensee whose license has expired no more than 60 days prior.
- 2. Any mixed beverage, caterer mixed beverage combination, or on-premise beer and wine licensee may renew their license without penalty so long as such renewal is completed no later than sixty (60) days following the expiration of the license.
