**Virginia Wangerin,
PhD, RN, CNE**

Dr. Virginia "Ginny" Wangerin is an educator, consultant, and speaker with over 40 years' experience in nursing. She has taught at the ADN, BSN and graduate level, and most recently developed and implemented the first nursing program at Iowa State University. Dr. Wangerin is recognized as a lifelong leader and nursing advocate, serving on numerous committees and boards, advocating for the profession and at-risk populations. She was profiled in "The American Nurse" as a nurse educator and advocate whose "efforts are aimed at improving the lives of patients and colleagues." She was honored by the Iowa Nurses Association with the Edith Ruppert Award, in recognition of having contributed significantly to the improvement of nursing and the professional organization. As a nurse education leader, she has developed and implemented concurrent enrollment programs and concept-based curriculum. Dr. Wangerin is a consultant and speaker for accreditation, curriculum development, learning strategies and outcomes assessment, and leadership development.

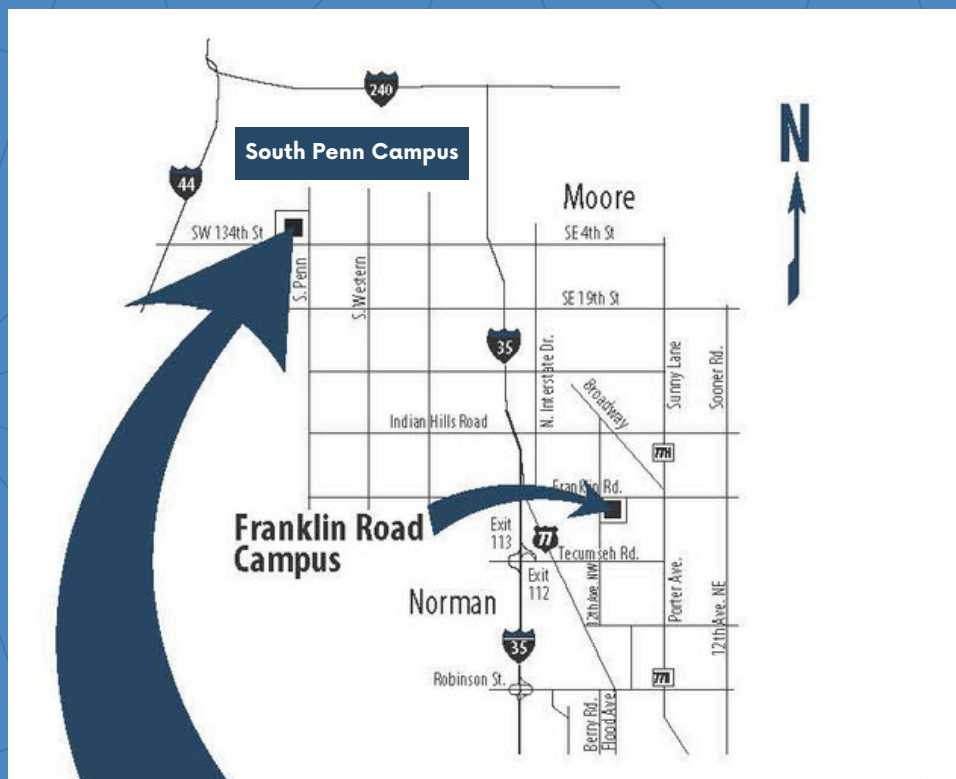

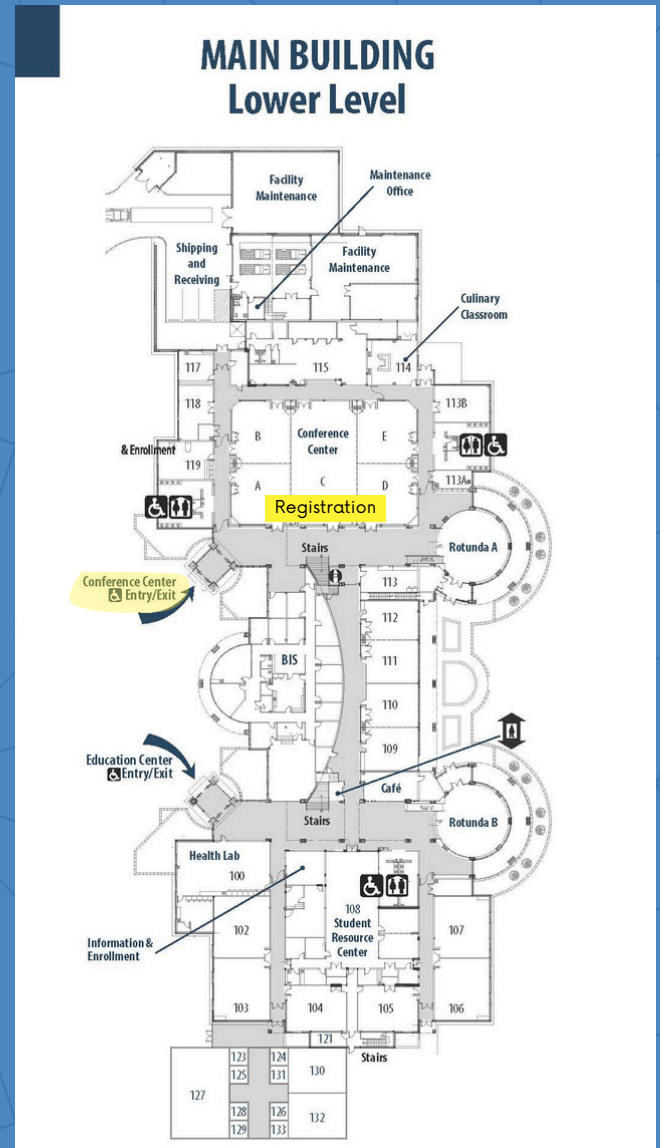

- **Directions:**

- **SOUTHBOUND and NORTHBOUND from I-35** - Take Exit 117 at SW 4th St., Moore, then travel west approximately three miles to SW 134th & S. Pennsylvania. The street name changes from SW 4th in Moore to SW 134th Street in Oklahoma City.
- **SOUTHBOUND and NORTHBOUND on I-44** - Take Exit 110 at SW 134th Street. Travel east 2.5 miles to SW 134th & South Pennsylvania. The campus is located on the northwest corner.
