[Here are seven things to know!](#) Native American history is preserved in government [archives](#), ancestral places, museums, and by the people today. The [National Park Service](#) manages sites of cultural significance, such as Alabama's [Russell Cave](#), featuring 10,000 years of human habitation; and the [Trail of Tears](#) National Historical Trail, which traces the migration of tribes forcibly removed from their Southeast U.S. homelands in 1838 and 1839. The Smithsonian's [National Museum](#) of the American Indian locations in Washington, D.C., and New York City also preserve Indigenous crafts and lifeways. In Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Historical Society lists each of the tribal nations with headquarters in Oklahoma.
