Examples of When an Inmate is Eligible for GPS

Examples of when an inmate is eligible for GPS based on sentence lengths.

Inmate is sentenced to 5 years and was placed at a minimum security facility/bed from the assessment and reception center. Inmate is eligible for GPS placement with approved home offer.

Inmate is sentenced to 4 years and was placed at a medium security facility/bed from the assessment and reception center. Inmate is eligible for GPS placement when he/she has less than 24 months remaining on the sentence.

Inmate is sentenced to 8 years and was placed at minimum security facility/bed from the assessment and reception center. Inmate is eligible for GPS placement when he/she has less than 24 months remaining on the sentence.

Inmate is sentenced to 5 years and was initially placed at medium security facility/bed from the assessment and reception center. Inmate is eligible for GPS when he/she has less than 24 months remaining on the sentence.

Inmate is sentenced to 11 years is eligible for GPS when he/she has less than 24 months remaining on the sentence.

Examples of when an inmate is eligible for GPS based on the listed crimes.

Inmate is sentenced to Manslaughter Second Degree in 1996. Sentence was completed in 2002. He is currently serving a 10 year sentence for Burglary Second Degree and has less than 24 months remaining on the sentence. If all other criteria are met, he is eligible for GPS due to the Manslaughter Second Degree crime is over 10 years old.

In 2014 Inmate received a conviction for Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon that has discharged. He is currently incarcerated on a 4 year sentence for Possession of CDS. He is not eligible for GPS due to the A&B with a Dangerous weapon is within the previous 10 years.

Inmate is sentenced to Rape Second Degree in 2005 completed in 2007. He is currently serving a conviction for Possession of CDS 64 O.S. 2-402 for 4 years and was initially placed at minimum. It was verified with Sex Offender Registration that he will register upon discharge. He is not eligible for GPS because he will have to register as a sex offender upon completion of the possession sentence.

Inmate is sentenced to Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle. In 2000, he was sentenced to 2 years Indecent Exposure. It was verified with Sex Offender Registration that the inmate has satisfied the registry and will not be required to register upon discharge. The inmate is eligible for GPS because the registry requirement is completed.

*If it is uncertain the inmate has to register as a sex offender at discharge, the case manager should contact the Sex and Violent Offender Registration's office. When verifying registry status have inmate's full name and DOC# ready to submit. A packet will not be prepared until verification is completed and only if the inmate is determined to be eligible. Inmate is sentenced to Caretaker Abuse* 21 O.S. 843.3 and completed the sentenced in 2015. He is currently serving a 12 year sentence for Forgery. He hasn't had a violent crime in the past 10 years. He will be eligible for GPS when he has less than 24 months to serve on the Forgery sentence due to the victim of the Caretaker Abuse was not in a nursing facility.

Inmate is sentenced to Caretaker Abuse of Resident in a Nursing Facility* 21 O.S. 843.3. Inmate is not ever eligible for GPS due to this conviction. The sentencing document must clearly state "resident in a nursing facility".

*If the J&S does not state Caretaker Abuse of Resident in a Nursing Facility, but there are other court documents in the file to indicate the victim was a resident of a nursing facility, the case manager should request that the facility records officer contact the district attorney's office to obtain an amended J&S before the packet is completed for GPS. When there are court documents containing conflicting information a packet will not be prepared until the matter is resolved and only if the inmate is determined to be eligible.

Inmate is sentenced to Child Neglect 21 O.S. 843.5. Inmate is not ever eligible for GPS due to this conviction.

Disqualifying Crimes for GPS Placement

Any attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation to commit any crime listed receives the score of the offense attempted, solicited or was the object of the conspiracy and will be considered the same as committing the offense when determining eligibility for GPS.

SUBJECT: Exception to OP-061001 Global Position Satellite Surveillance (GPS)

Program for the House Bill No.2630

On May 8, 2018, Governor Mary Fallin signed House Bill No. 2630 modifying the eligibility requirements for the Electronic Monitoring Program, updating language and declaring an emergency. Beginning in June 2017 major revisions have been taking place in order to combine policies (e.g., GPS, EMP) and consolidate all criteria for inmate movement into one policy. Since these changes are still in process an exception to OP-061001 entitled "Global Position Satellite Surveillance (GPS) Program" requested to implement the changes contained in House Bill No. 2630.

The following language is currently used in policy regarding eligibility requirements:

Section I. GPS Program Criteria, I. A. Eligibility requirements;

- 1. Must be serving a sentence of five years or less and whose initial placement is not higher than minimum security level; or
- 2. Must have no more than 11 months left to serve on their total term of incarceration.

The following represents 11 months projected time left to serve for each earned credit level:

3. Inmates must have been incarcerated for at least 90 days.

B. Exclusionary Criteria

- Inmates serving a conviction during the current incarceration or convicted within the previous ten 10 years for a highest offense as listed on the "Offense Severity Categories" (OP-060101(M) (F), Attachment A.
- 2. Inmates convicted of any violation of the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs Act, Section 2-414 et. seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 3. Inmates denied parole within the previous 12 months pursuant to Section 332.7 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 4. Inmates removed from the EMP program, or any other alternative to incarceration program authorized by law (PPCS/SSP/EMP), for violation of any rule or condition of the program and reassigned to imprisonment in a correctional facility.
- 5. Inmates who have escaped from a penal or correctional institution within the previous ten years.

The following exceptions to policy is being requested:

Section I. GPS Program Criteria, I. A. Eligibility requirements;

- 1. Inmates with a sentence length of less than or equal to 5 years and who are placed at a minimum security facility from the assessment and reception center; or
- 2. Inmates with less than 24 months remaining.

The following represents **24 months projected time left to serve** for each earned credit level:

3. Inmates must have a home offer.

B. Exclusionary Criteria

- 1. Inmates serving a conviction of a violent offense within the previous ten years or convicted of a violation enumerated in Section 13.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 2. Inmates who have escaped from a medium or maximum custody penal or correctional institution within the previous ten years.

Language not included in the above "Exclusionary Criteria" modification section was removed from the statute.
