DECLARATION OF ELECTION EMERGENCY 2022-02

WHEREAS on Friday, November 4, 2022, a severe storm occurred at the Trinity Baptist Church, located at 2805 E. Washington Street in Idabel, Oklahoma 74745; and

WHEREAS this location serves as a polling place for Precinct 450008 in McCurtain County; and

WHEREAS voting cannot occur at this location due to the storm damage, so the McCurtain County Election Board Secretary has requested to relocate the polling place for Precinct 450008, on an emergency basis to the Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, located at 200 Calvary Lane in Idabel, Oklahoma 74745, which is within the boundaries of Precinct 450008.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Paul Ziriaux, Secretary of the State Election Board, pursuant to the power vested in me by Paragraph 1 of Subsection A of Section 22-101 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes hereby declare and order the following:

1. An election emergency exists in Precinct 450008 in McCurtain County for the election being held on Tuesday, November 08, 2022.
2. The Secretary of the McCurtain County Election Board is authorized to temporarily relocate, on an emergency basis, the polling place for Precinct 450008 to the Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, located at 200 Calvary Lane in Idabel, Oklahoma 74745.
3. The Secretary of the McCurtain County Election Board shall make every reasonable effort to notify the public and local news media of the relocation of the polling place for Precinct 450008. The Secretary will also post notice of relocation at the former polling place.
4. The inspector, judge, clerk, and other precinct officials assigned to Precinct 450008 shall, for the election held on November 08, 2022, conduct voting for this precinct at the Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, located at 200 Calvary Lane in Idabel, Oklahoma 74745.

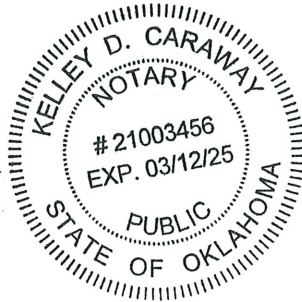
