Reports on IACREOT and Election Center Conferences

Provisional Voting and Voter Identification Requirements

Work is proceeding on drafts of rules to implement the provisional voting and voter identification requirements of HAVA in 2004. The Secretary will adopt emergency rules later this year, and also will seek passage of law addressing this issue early in the 2004 session of the Legislature.
