Breastfeeding Legislation Cards Order Form

Free wallet cards are available to the public. These cards explain the Oklahoma breastfeeding laws from 2004, 2020, and 2021, and the National Law from 2010. In 2004, legislation was passed acknowledging that mothers have the right to breastfeed in public places and also exempting breastfeeding mothers from jury duty. In 2010, the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act was passed that states employers shall provide reasonable break time and a private place for an employee to express breast milk for her nursing child for one year. In 2020, Oklahoma passed legislation supporting paid break time for State employees to express milk or breastfeed. In 2021, Oklahoma passed legislation stating public school teachers and employees must be given paid break time to express milk or breastfeed.
