


Remember to brush twice a day for two minutes. Brushing every night is

How to **Brush Your Teeth**


Do not scrub teeth; Gently brush teeth.



Brush using light vibratory and roll motion.



Brush the outside, inside and tops of the teeth.

Gently move floss between two teeth in a seesaw motion.



Wrap the floss in a "C" shape around the tooth. Slide the floss under the gum and move up and down several times to clean.



For those that are unable to use floss for interproximal cleaning, Floss Picks, Soft-Picks or an interproximal brush may be used.








Dentures should be brushed daily.



1. Place a towel or water in the sink to prevent breakage.



2. Hold denture in the palm of your hand. Scrub denture with the denture brush and paste. Rinse



3. Remove residents' dentures/partials every night and store in a labeled container with clean water.




Daily Oral **Hygiene Saves Lives**
