WHAT IS SEVERE MATERNAL MORBIDITY?

Severe Maternal Morbidity (SMM) includes unexpected outcomes of labor and delivery that result in significant short or long-term consequences to a woman's health.¹

TOP CAUSES OF SMM FOR OKLAHOMA MOTHERS

2021

- Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome (ARDS)
- · Acute Renal Failure
- Disseminated Intravascular Coagulation (DIC)



RISK FACTORS FOR SMM³

- · Pre-existing chronic conditions
- · Older maternal age
- · Current or former smoker



Approximately

25,000-30,000 deliveries per year
