Welcome & Introductions:

Morgan Fitzgerald, co-chair, opened the meeting by welcoming all and briefed all attendees on the topics that would be covered today.

Healthy Brain Initiative Issue Map:

Morgan shared her screen and the group looked at the 5 action items under Monitor and Evaluate the workgroup will be focusing on for the new ADRD State Plan. Morgan announced that M-1 is already asked for this Grant Year (GY) since it is in her budget for 2022. It will also be placed in the GY 3 budget, but feels it should stay in the state plan for future years.

The required action item is M-3: Use data gleaned through available surveillance strategies and other sources to inform the public health program and policy response to cognitive health, impairment and caregiving. We discussed the examples in the issue map from South Dakota and Summit County of a needs assessment. It was a consensus that we should do our own needs assessment. Nadine said the Caregiver Coalition would be willing to work together on a caregivers needs assessment.
