Keri gave a brief update on bills and introduced Maggie Shaffer as the new Director of Policy at the Alzheimer's Association and co-chair of the Policy Workgroup.

Group Discussion:

To focus on the Healthy Brain Policy Action Models.

Started the discussion with P-5: Engage public and private partners in ongoing planning efforts to establish services and policies that promote supportive communities and workplaces for people with dementia and their caregivers.

- Working Public/Private Partnerships:
 - Keri let everyone know that the OK State Conference on Aging will be May 6th. There will be live and virtual options. Next year they plan to have satellite locations across the state.
 - The main goal for the satellite areas will be for state employees to receive CEUS and for the public to receive information on programs and services
 - Brain Guide- US Against Alzheimer's interested in partnering with OHBI- Melissa will set up a meeting with them and Morgan.
 - Memory Questionnaire and Brain Health Resources | BrainGuide (mybrainguide.org)
 - OUHSC/GWEP- Partner to promote caregiver education, Age/Dementia Friendly Health Systems and Communities, and on Dementia Friendly @Work training
- Partnerships we would like to see:
 - VA has a new director
 - wants to make sure they are a part of OHBI
 - o Broyles Foundation- Dementia Friendly Businesses
 - OHBI is planning to be a member of Dementia Friendly America. We are planning the criteria for designation for communities, businesses, faith organizations, schools, etc.
 - Senior Dog Rescue- Enid: can we partner with them? Most of them give up their dogs due to being unable to care for them anymore
 - Is there an opportunity for training for their interactions with the seniors giving up their pets?
 - Alzheimer's Association- Support Group Facilitator training
 - Well Persevered Advisors are going to start a support group at their office
 - Need more businesses to be a host for these groups
 - Ombudsmen Advisory Committee- looking for more volunteers: this training may be interested in this training
