	There were no reports or undates				



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- - 1. Decrease the number of Priority 1 patients transported by ambulance services to a Level III or Level IV Trauma Center by 3% by the end of the calendar year 2021
  - 2. Decrease the statewide average length of stay at Level III and Level IV Trauma Centers for patients having an ISS of ≥16 by 3% by the end of the calendar year 2021

Mr. Bruner stated we needed more current data because the Region may have met the goal already. Ms. Beggs said the committee needs to look at the bordering Texas hospitals to see how they would fit into this process. Mr. Gay shared that Paris Regional has a representative that comes by every month to his agency (City of Antlers). Ms. Keele shared that many hospitals are doing unnecessary diagnostic testing before they transfer a P-1 patient. That once they realize they have a P-1 patient that needs to go that steps need to be taken to get the patient out quicker. The radiology reading are taking up to three hours to get results and to start the transfer process quicker. Ms. Beggs requested to get up to date data at least for 2019. No further action was taken.

Ms. Beggs reported the Regional Medical Response System is working on a plan for Region 5 to be a part of the surgical extraction team which would include taking surgeons to the scenes to provide care. The RMRS is planning to meet with the physicians and surgeons this month for planning.
