- C. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to approve a plan to:
  - 1. Decrease the number of Priority 1 patients transported by ambulance services to a Level III or Level IV Trauma Center by 3% by the end of the calendar year 2022.
  - 2. Decrease the statewide average length of stay at Level III and Level IV Trauma Centers for patients having an ISS of ≥16 by 3% by the end of calendar year 2022.

The committee tabled this item until the trauma plan edits are finished. No action taken.
