Community Ambulance Service is a financially stable EMS that is funded by a 3 Mil advalorem tax and collected charges for services rendered. The primary coverage area is approximately 1100 square miles with an approximate 2250 residents.

Community Ambulance Service is a primary paid volunteer service (EMT's and EMR's) with 2 full time paramedics covering 24/7. The service is governed by the Community Ambulance Service Board of Directors appointed by the Dewey County Board of Commissioners.
