Checotah EMS covers the north end of the county primarly, they are tax supported by the City of Checotah. Muskogee Co and Okmulgee Co have agreed to cover the areas that border their counties. Paramed EMS currently covers the southern and western ends of the County. Pulse EMS has signaled their intentions to place a substation in Eufaula. The 911 Trust Authority has started planning for the possible addition of Pulse to emergency calls.
