

SFY 2015 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

July Invoice Report

Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 14 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 14 FQHCs, 9 submitted invoices, and of these 9, only 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.

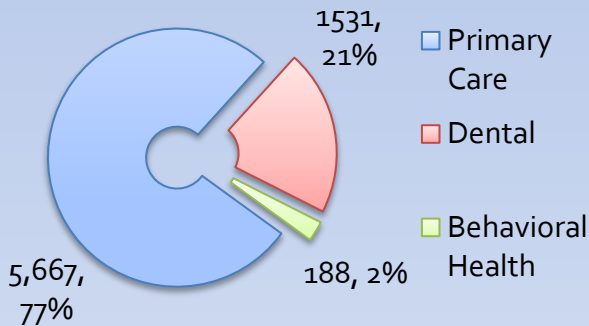

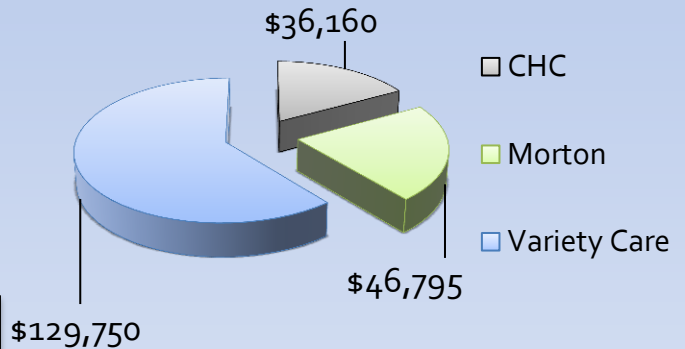

UCF Reimbursement



For services provided in July, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 1,280 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$241,093.39

Total UCF Available = \$212,706.41

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 88% of their requested reimbursement amount.
