MINUTES

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Jason Likens at 1:03 pm.

II. Welcome and Introduction

Eddie Sims introduced Brittney Magill as the Chief Nursing Officer of Norman Regional Health, Mike Combs as an EMSSTAT Crew Chief, and Jan Emmons as the NRHS EMSSTAT Director. Holley Costner introduced herself as a Norman Regional Emergency Room Physician.

III. Roll Call

Roll call was taken with quorum met; members present and absent reflected on the attached attendance sheet.

IV. Approval of Minutes – May 15th, 2018

A motion to approve the May 15th, 2018 minutes as written was made by EMSSTAT and seconded by McClain-Grady County EMS. There was no discussion and the motion passed 11-0.

V. Reports/Updates

- A. Emergency Systems Quarterly Activity Report and Presentations Dan Whipple announced that State Question 788 had passed and that all questions should be directed to the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority with resources and contact information provided. He then gave a brief overview of TReC data and data collected regarding the approved Regional CQI Indicators for the dates of January 1st, 2018 through June 30th, 2018. At the request of members, TReC data will be emailed prior to scheduled meetings for review with data reviewed at this meeting to be emailed with the meeting summary. Jennifer Woodrow announced staffing changes at the Oklahoma Department of Health to include Dr. Julie Myers as the new Service Director for Medical Facilities, Dr. LaTrina Frazier as the new Assistant Director for Medical Facilities, and Rocky McElvany as the new Deputy Commissioner of Protective Health Services. Dr. Kenneth Stewart with the Trauma Registry will be leaving Emergency Systems with his last day to be August 24th, 2018. Effective July 5th, 2018, the Oklahoma EMS Information System (OKEMSIS) will reject files using color-coded triage for all runs created on or after July 1st, 2018. Updates to OKEMSIS include expansion of trauma codes by 22 impression codes and inclusion of "fallback" codes.
