#### **MINUTES**

#### I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair Russell Martin at 1:00 pm

#### II. **Roll Call**

Roll call was taken and all Board Members were present except for Bailey Medical Center Owasso, Oklahoma Surgical Hospital, and Shadow Mountain Hospital; quorum was met. See the attached attendance list for all members.

#### III. **Introductions and Announcements**

Chair Russell Martin welcomed everyone to EMSA - East and offered the opportunity for everyone to tour the facility. Jeremy McLemore was introduced as the new director for the Regional Medical Response System.

#### Approval of Minutes – January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 IV.

A motion was made by Theresa Compos and seconded by Creek County EMS. The motion did not pass because Creek County is not a Board Member.

#### ٧. Reports

#### **Emergency Systems Quarterly Activity Report**

Dean Henke presented the Emergency Systems report. Mr. Henke announced that he would be the new Region 7 RTAB Coordinator because Ethan Barstow has left the department for outside employment.


Oklahoma Trauma Education Program: The Trauma Division is presenting OTEP regionally over the next few months. This is a train-the-trainer course, so after you attend an OTEP class, you can take the information back to your agency to train your own employees. Dan Whipple shared that the OSDH is in the process of making OTEP a requirement for renewing your State License, but it is not mandatory at this time.

Oklahoma Trauma Emergency Response Advisory Council: Currently there is an EMS regulation workgroup where they are brainstorming ideas for regulation changes. The next workgroup meeting is April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 – 1:00 – OSDH – Room 1102. Also there is an EMRsource workgroup which will meet May 17<sup>th</sup>, 2019 – 1:30 pm – OSDH – Rm 1102. Regional Updates: Region 3 RTAB approved to send letters to ED Medical Directors and Trauma Registrars to stress the importance of documenting the time the decision to transfer was made.

#### B. Regional Quarterly Activity Reports

- 1. Regional Planning Committee did not meet because of not making quorum.
- Quality Improvement Committee was presented by Ms. Brandee Keele and she
  informed the group the QIC did not meet because of not making quorum. Ms. Keele
  informed the group that the Quality Assurance Medical Records Request form was
  changed to help facilities improve the medical records needed for the QIC.
- 3. Metropolitan Medical Response System presented by Mr. Jeremey McLemore, the new RMRS Director. Mr. McLemore shared they received their Federal Guidelines for the next year which is adding a response capability for all Regional Medical Response Systems. There have been five red flags for fire danger this month. There will be a conference coming up in April on wild land fire rehab. Plans for 2020 are to develop a pediatric disaster response plan.

## C. EMS for Children Quarterly Activity Report

Dean Henke shared that EMS-C is a statewide pediatric resource and education center based at OU Children's Hospital since 1992. They provide pediatric training, equipment, and resources for the State of Oklahoma. There is an opportunity to receive free training for Pediatric Emergency Assessment Recognition and Stabilization (PEARS) and Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) on multiple training dates. ## VI. Business

A. Discussion of presentation "Venomous Snakes in Oklahoma" and identification of need to include in regional planning and possible vote to send the item to the Regional Planning Committee

Chair Russell Martin opened the floor for discussion about the need for an Envenomation plan for Region 7. Mr. Dan Whipple asked the group about the facilities that did not have at least 6 vials of the Crofab. All facilities present did have at least six vials in stock. Mr. Martin asked if EMResource could list all facilities that carry Antivenin. Ms. Grace Pelley informed the group that the OSDH could put a link on EMResouce to the Poison Control Center who has all the resources at hand in regards to snake bites. Discussion was to send the snakebite presentation item to the RPC to consider a regional plan for Region 7. A motion was made to send the item to the RPC by Brianne Smedley and was seconded by KC Nickels. The motion passed 15-0.

B. Vote to task the RPC or create a work group to draft a NEDOCS utilization plan for RTAB consideration

Ms. Pelley presented a NEDOCS handout which outlines important points about NEDOCS. Ms. Pelley said that NEDOCS would be turned on at midnight April  $16^{th}$ , 2019 to go live statewide. Ms. Pelley challenged Region 7 to create a workgroup to expand NEDOCS to a higher level for the region. Ms. Kathy O'Dell suggested that the RTAB create a workgroup for this task. Mr. Whipple reminded the group to RSVP if they will attend the workgroup so the attendance can be monitored to prevent reaching quorum. A motion was made to create a NEDOCS workgroup from the RTAB by James L. Annas Jr. and was seconded by Kathy O'Dell. The motion passed 15-0

#### VII. Presentation

"Preparing for Chemical Emergencies" Public Health Lab (PHL) — OSDH- Leslie Billetter
Ms. Billetter presented to the group that there are 53 PHL across the United States. The OSDH
PHL assists agencies with what to collect, how to ship samples, and how to develop a chemical
response plan. She discussed multiple worst case scenarios and problems that could arise. Mr.
Whipple asked the RTAB group how many agencies are prepared for a chemical response and he
shared that the RMRS is tasked with conducting a drill in the future.

## VIII. Public Comment

**Ms. Michelle Steele** with Genentech shared that she has lanyards to hand out. Also they can help provide artwork to facilities that promotes stroke awareness.

Ms. Pelley discussed the meeting for the Oklahoma State Stroke Systems Advisory Committee (OSSSAC) which is to be held April 17<sup>th</sup>, 1:00 pm. She also announced that OTERAC will defer any items in regards to stroke to the OSSSAC because they have the expertise in regards to stroke. Also in regards to OTERAC, the systems development workgroup is meeting Thursday April 18<sup>th</sup> – 10:00 am – Rm 1102 at OSDH. Ms. Pelley announced that pediatric traumatic brain injuries will be the topic for the 3rd quarter RTAB.

Mr. KC Nickels asked how many people the RPC was short in not meeting quorum. Mr. Henke shared they were one short and the issue seems to be the time of the RPC meeting. Mr. Henke also discussed the option of changing the RPC meeting time to later to shorten the time gap between the RPC and RTAB meeting.

**Mr. Whipple** shared that if anyone from your agency would be interested in joining the RPC to send Dean an email and then that name will be presented to the RTAB to be approved.
