- 1.Q. Can grant funds be utilized to hire new employees?
  - 1.A. There is not a prohibition to hiring employees within the statute or regulations.
- 2.Q. Can grant funds be utilized to hire a consultant; i.e. to perform training, analyze data, etc.
  - 2.A. There is not a prohibition to hiring a consultant within the statute or regulations.
- 3.Q. It appears that the calculation for DISTANCE TO TRAUMA CENTER has changed. In years past this was the furthest point in the coverage area and now this is an average of the furthest and closest. Is this the correct number to utilize?
  - 3.A. The distance to the trauma center is quoted from the regulation. (See 310:641-5-1 (D))
  - 4.A. While DISTANCE TO TRAUMA CENTER is now an average, NUMBER OF EMTs in the coverage area is not. With multiple areas (zip codes) covered, is it possible for this number to be an average also?
- 4.Q. No. The regulation for the scoring of the number of EMT's is based on the fewer resident licensed EMT's in the project area. (See 310:641-5-1 (E))
