Description of Amendment:

a. This is to incorporate the following:

This amendment is to answer all questions presented by the deadline (June 21, 2019 3:00 PM CST). All Reponses MUST be turned in no later than July 26, 2019, Also be sure to attach the signed amendments

Q1. For CLIN #2 – the title line says "K2 Scientific Model: K223SDR or equivalent 23 cu. ft. Laboratory/Medical Upright Glass Door Refrigerator"; but in the description it says, "Solid Door". It does make a difference because the glass door is less expensive than the solid door. Which do you prefer – glass or solid door?

E-Mail Address

Response: "SDR" in the K2 Scientific Model refers to "Solid Door". All refrigerators must have a solid door.

Q2. For CLIN #3 – the description of this does say solid door, and doesn't mention a glass door anywhere else. I just thought I would check and make sure that you did want a solid door for this one too. Again, there is an upcharge for the solid door.

Response: All refrigerators must have a solid door.

Q3. Since these are for vaccines, and we have this equipment on our Federal Government Federal Supply Schedule, I was wondering if you have authorization to use GSA pricing? If you have a letter of authorization; or operating under something like a federal government emergency preparedness grant, or you have other reasons that you have this authority, we would be happy to quote this with our GSA pricing.

Response: Pricing to be offered is to be determined by the vendor. OSDH's ability to use GSA contracts as purchasing vehicles depends on which GSA contract applies and in some cases the circumstances of the purchase. All proposed awards using an allowable GSA contract vehicle as subject to the requirements set forth here (include hyperlink to OMES PIM on GSA contracts). OSDH is not requesting GSA contract (quotes or bids, depending on if the solicitation is an RFQ or an ITB) in response to this solicitation. Purchasing through a GSA contract is an alternative purchasing method to an award made pursuant to this solicitation. If a GSA quote is submitted, OSDH may or may not consider pursuing a GSA contract award as it determines to be allowable and in its best interest.
