

FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

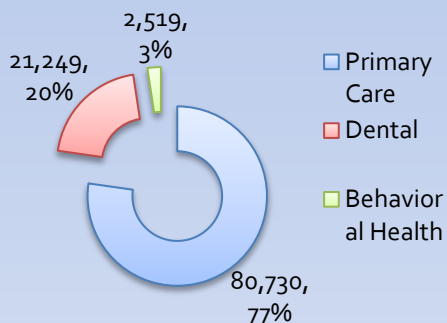
SFY 2015 Annual Report

Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 14 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 14 FQHCs, 12 submitted invoices, and of these 12, only 6 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.

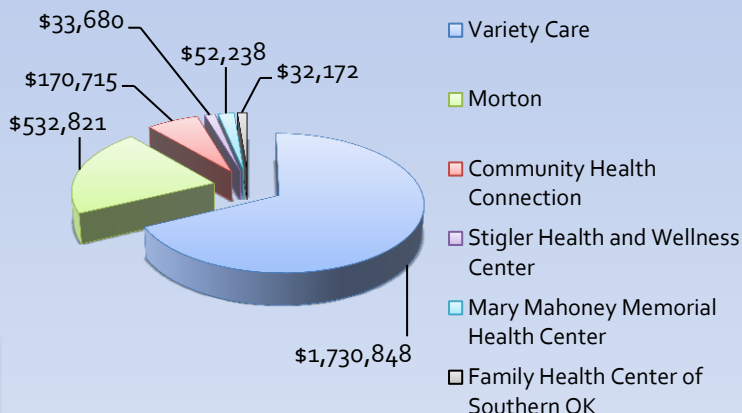

For services provided in SFY 2015, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 15,437 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$4,006,521.57

Total UCF Available = \$2,552,476.00

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 63.70% of their requested reimbursement amount.
