

# FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

SFY 2016 Annual Report July 2015 – March 8, 2016

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 15 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 15 FQHCs, 13 submitted invoices, and of these 13, only 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.

**Note:** \* Number of patients/encounters only includes months in which the FQHC was eligible for reimbursement.

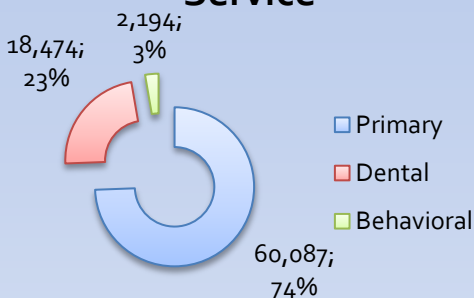

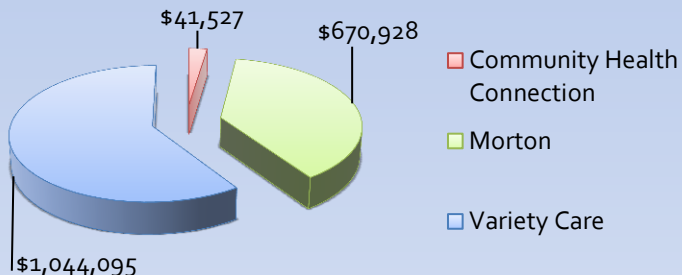

## UCF Reimbursement



For services provided from July 1, 2015 to March 8, 2016, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 9,701 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$2,893,714.99  
Total UCF Available = \$1,756,550.80\*

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 60.70% of their requested reimbursement amount.

**Note:** \*Less than State appropriated funds due to discontinuation of UCF March 8, 2016.
