PART I: REQUEST TO CONSIDER ELIGIBILITY – REQUIRED

I hereby state that I have been convicted of, or plead guilty or nolo contendere to a crime that disqualifies me from acquiring or holding a CPA or PA certificate or license pursuant to Section 10:15-37-11 of the Oklahoma Administrative Code. I request that the Oklahoma Accountancy Board ("OAB") consider my application or ability to sit for the exam in the future despite my criminal history.

I have included the following documentation for the OAB's review:

- A copy of my criminal history record;
- An explanation of each conviction, the date of conviction, the court of jurisdiction, and the sentence imposed;
- Any additional information you wish the Board to consider, such as: length of time since the crime was committed, evidence of rehabilitation, information about current circumstances, testimonials or personal reference statements, employment aspirations, etc.
- A \$95 non-refundable fee for processing this request. This fee can be paid through cash, check, or money order. Please make the check or money order payable to the OAB.
