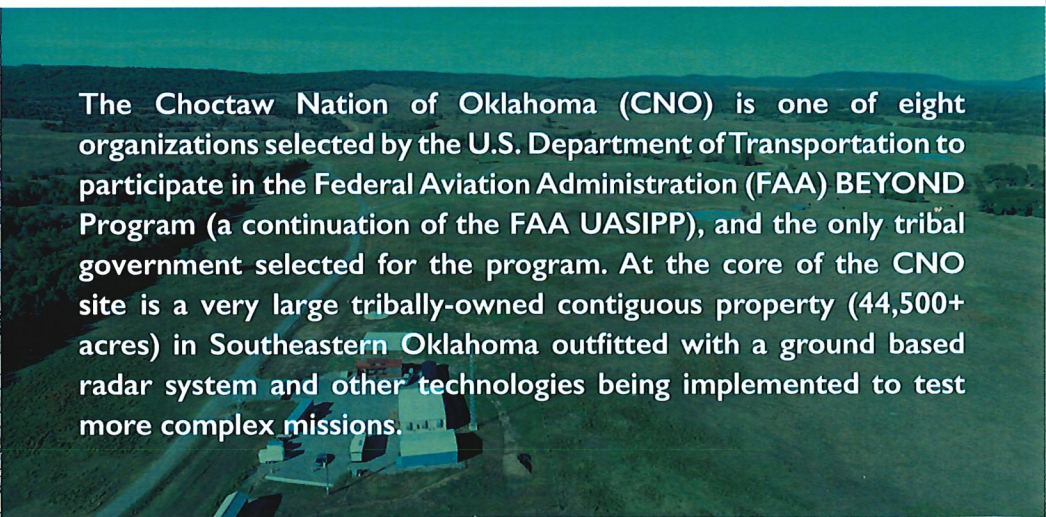
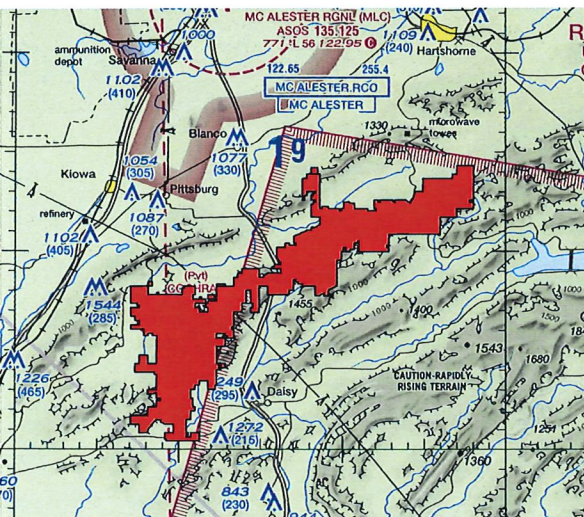

## Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma - FAA BEYOND Program



The Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (CNO) is one of eight organizations selected by the U.S. Department of Transportation to participate in the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) BEYOND Program (a continuation of the FAA UASIPP), and the only tribal government selected for the program. At the core of the CNO site is a very large tribally-owned contiguous property (44,500+ acres) in Southeastern Oklahoma outfitted with a ground based radar system and other technologies being implemented to test more complex missions.

The CNO BEYOND program is focused on advancing “beyond visual line-of-sight” (BVLOS) drone operations and small cargo delivery by drone, as well as other advanced drone operations, but other emerging aviation technology testing is welcomed and supported.

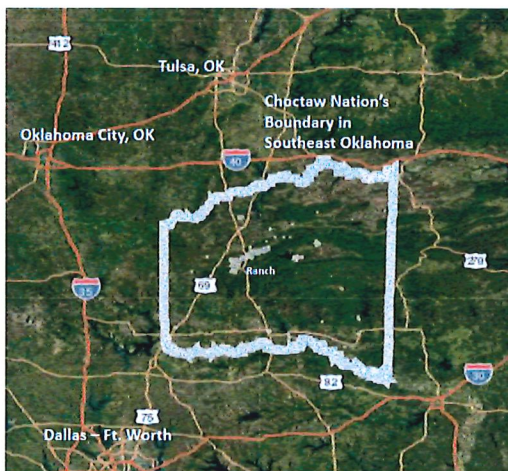

The Choctaw Nation's Ranch at Daisy on the west side, and the Choctaw Nation's Ranch at Ti Valley on the east side are 25 geodesic miles from one end to the other and total 69 square miles.



**Choctaw Ranch is:**

- 125 miles to Plano, TX
- 130 miles to Tulsa Airport
- 115 miles to Ft. Smith, AR
- 150 miles to Oklahoma City, OK
- 145 miles to DFW Airport
