



POSTER CONTEST AGE CATEGORY DIVISIONS - All students attending home, private, charter or public school in Oklahoma are eligible in the following groups:

- Group I — Junior Category (Born between Jan. 1, 2014 and December 31, 2017)
- Group II — Intermediate Category (Born between Jan. 1, 2010 and Dec. 31, 2013)
- Group III — Senior Category (Born between Jan. 1, 2006 and Dec. 31, 2009)

POSTER CONTEST RULES:

The required format is 11" x 17". If this is unobtainable, the nearest possible equivalent. Artwork must NOT be framed or outlined with borders. All artwork must be done by hand (or, in the case of physically challenged children, by foot or mouth). Any of the following media are permitted: watercolor, acrylic, oil paint, indelible marker pens, felt-tip pens, soft ball-point pens, indelible ink, Crayola or any similar indelible medium. The following media are NOT permitted: pencil, charcoal or other non-permanent medium; computer-generated artwork; or collage work involving the use of photocopies. Landscape oriented images are preferred for calendar reproduction purposes.

- Must be student's ORIGINAL slogan and artwork. No signatures on posters.
- No syndicated, copyrighted, clipart images or inappropriate content allowed!
- ATTACH COMPLETED ENTRY FORM/CERTIFICATE OF AUTHENTICITY on back upper right corner of poster. The following information should be clearly shown on the back of the artwork: title, family name, given name, address, date of birth, name and address of school which the child attends, and certificate of authenticity. There is no need for a title on the poster and entrants can decide for themselves whether or not to include one. However, there should be a clearly recognizable link to the theme of the contest as well as aviation and aerospace.
- Reproducibility factors into the judging, so use good lettering, high contrast, and bright colors.
- Please follow poster contest rules or face disqualification of poster entry. Once received, entries become (and remain) the property of the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and may be used for a variety of purposes.

CONTEST DEADLINE:

Poster entries must be delivered or post-marked by January 9, 2024, to the Oklahoma Department of Aerospace and Aeronautics offices at 110 N. Robinson Ave., Suite 200, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73102.

THEME: Posters must be an ORIGINAL concept. Posters should be artistic, "POSITIVE" in approach and wording, and focus on the aviation and aerospace theme.
