LICENSING INFORMATION FOR OCC LICENSED TESTER

Any person who performs tank system testing in the State of Oklahoma must have a current license. Testing completed by a non-licensed person will not be accepted.

THE APPLICATION PROCESS

- Application and supporting documents need to be submitted to the Petroleum Storage Tank Division along with a \$50.00 check or money order made out to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (OCC)/Petroleum Storage Tank Division (PSTD) for the application fee. Application fees are non-refundable. DO NOT INCLUDE THE LICENSING FEE OR YOUR APPLICATION AND ORIGINAL PAYMENT WILL BE RETURNED.
- 2) If your application is approved, you will be invoiced for your license fee.
- 3) If your application is denied or more information is needed, we will send you a denial letter or request more information.
- 4) Your license will be mailed out as soon as we receive the license fee.

Please be sure you have enclosed the following with your application if applicable.

- Certificate(s) from testing equipment manufacturer
- Proof of passing result for PEI RP 1200 Exam
