Filing Your Request for OUSF Funding

All Requests for OUSF Funding must be filed with the Commission's Court Clerk. The below information provides an overview of the process. If you have additional questions concerning the filing of your Request, please contact the Court Clerk at (405) 522-8976. **NOTICE: In our continuing response to the COVID-19 pandemic, please read updated instructions on remote participation and remote filing instructions [here](#).**

- The Commission's Court Clerk's business hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding State holidays. The Court Clerk is frequently busy in the afternoons; therefore, we encourage you to file any Requests in the morning. **Due to COVID-19 and restricted access to Jim Thorpe Building, all OUSF filings should be sent to okcfilings@occ.ok.gov.**
- There is no filing fee for Requests filed on the Oklahoma Universal Service Fund Docket ("OSF Docket").

Continued...

- Pursuant to OAC 165:5-1-5(f), **filing documents on the OSF Docket by fax is prohibited.**
- **Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, OUSF causes may be filed by email to okcfilings@occ.ok.gov.** When filing, be sure to include the Request, SUSF, and summary worksheet. All other attachments should be sent to the OUSF Administrator.
- The supporting documentation must be submitted directly to the Administrator in-person, or sent via email to OUSF@occ.ok.gov. For documents that have a file size over 10 MB, please contact the Administrator to determine the best method for transferring the documentation.
- A copy of the Request and one set of supporting documentation is required to be delivered to the Oklahoma Attorney General (“AG”). To ensure that you have the accurate contact information for the AG, please contact the Administrator.
- Additionally, a copy of the Request should be provided to the Beneficiary, and upon request, to each telecommunications carrier in the State of Oklahoma. The Administrator shall provide a list of the contributors to the OUSF upon request.

Checklist

Request:

- Caption completed and reviewed for typos.
- Provider name listed as registered with the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.
- Provider contact's name, phone number, and email listed.
- Beneficiary name and address are correct.
- Lump Sum and Monthly Recurring amounts and dates match the dates and amounts on the SUSF summary worksheet.
- All entries completed and reviewed for typos.

Request, SUSF & worksheet (excel version), and Certificate of Service are filed with the Commission's Court Clerk's office.

Supporting documentation to be submitted directly to the Administrator (all Beneficiaries):

- Preapproval Funding Letter (if issued).
- Contract/Agreement for all funding years in Request.
- Invoices and explanation of any credits or adjustments other than E-rate/OUSF credits.
- Completed and signed Affidavit.
- Affidavit attachments:
 - Network Diagram.
 - Copies of FCC Forms 470, 471, RFP, and other federal funding program documentation (**Schools and Libraries**).
 - Copy of all bids received, including bids that were not considered, and all evaluation documents.
 - Additional documentation for **Healthcare** entities:
 - Copy of current certificate or license which identifies its qualification as a Healthcare Entity.
 - Copy of Healthcare Entity's qualification/verification as part of a consortium.
 - Copy of current verification of not-for-profit status, if applicable.
 - Copy of all applicable FCC Forms completed by the Healthcare Entity-these would include but are not limited to FCC Forms 465, 466, and 467, or FCC Forms 461, 462, and 463, along with the Funding Commitment Letter and Network Cost Worksheet for Consortia.
 - Supporting documentation that verifies exemption from competitive bidding requirements, if applicable.
