The Project has been under active development for several years. The most recent FAA form 7460-1 filing was made on January 21, 2016. A summary of the FAA form 7460-1 filing for each existing building tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. The FAA form 7460-1 filing was submitted to the FAA on January 21, 2016.

In accordance with the OK Statute 180.21, the Company also confirms it is submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Caddo County and Commission Council of the Commission on the town adjacent to the town of Hinton, Oklahoma. No project facilities are located within an incorporated area of a municipality, and thus no additional notice is required under OK Statute 180.21.

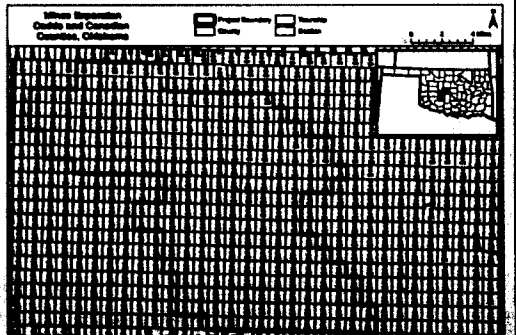

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT

In order to comply with the requirements of Section 2 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 106, codified as Section 106.21 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 17, (collectively referred herein as "OK Siting Law"), which was approved by the legislature and signed by the Governor, and in accordance with certain rules that are to be promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to the provisions of OK Siting Law, Item 2, "Construction," hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Mingo Expansion wind energy project (the "Project") located in Caddo County and Canadian County, Oklahoma.

The Project has been under active development for several years. The most recent FAA Form 7460-1 filing was made on January 21, 2016. A summary of the FAA Form 7460-1 filing for each well tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B to this notice presents a diagram showing the real estate analyzed and included in statutory setback compliance. As of the date of this notice, and based on publicly available data, Company asserts that the Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Siting Law.

In accordance with the OK Siting Law, the Company also certifies it is submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Caddo County and Canadian County Board of Commissioners in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C. No project facilities are located within an incorporated area of a municipality, and thus no additional notice is required under OK Siting Law.
