

Application Checklist for Certified Problem Gambling Treatment Counselors

Step 1: Initial Submission to OAPGG

All Applicants

- Completed Gambling Counselor Certification Application form
- Signed Gambling Counselor Ethical Standards statement

Additional Requirements

New Applicants

- Copy of current license
- Copy of certificate of completion of basic training for problem gambling (and documentation of course content if training was out of state)
- Group Case Consultation and Presentation form
- Supervised Hours for Problem Gambling Related Work form

Grandfathered Applicants

- Copy of current license
- Copy of NCGC or ICGC certification
- Documentation of 10 hours of gambling-specific CEUs in the past 12 months

Returning Applicants

- Copy of current license
- Documentation of 10 hours of gambling-specific CEUs in the past 12 months

Step 2: Approval by ODMHSAS

All Applicants

- Submit the application fee to the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services (ODMHSAS)
