1. Item No. 96 - Transportation Safety Improvement Projects – Mr. Pendley

a) Choctaw, Leflore, Marshall, McCurtain and Pushmataha Counties - District II

We have received a request from the Division II Engineer for the installation of pavement markings, centerline and shoulder rumble strips at the following locations:

1. US-377/SH-99: Beginning at the Red River extending north approximately 8.9 miles to the Junction of US-377/SH-99 and SH-32, in Marshall County;
2. US-70: Beginning at the Junction of US-259, SH-3 and US-70, in the city of Broken Bow, extending east approximately 6.1 miles and then beginning approximately 9.7 miles east of the Junction of US-259, SH-3 and US-70 extending east approximately 6.0 miles to the Arkansas State line, in McCurtain County;
3. US-259: Beginning at approximately 4.6 miles north of the McCurtain County line extending north approximately 11.2 miles to the Junction of SH-63 and US-259, in Leflore County;
4. US-271/SH-9: Beginning at the Junction of US-271, US-59 and SH-9 extending east approximately 3.2 miles to Lakeview Rd., in the City of Spiro, in Leflore County;
5. US-59/SH-9: Beginning at the Haskell County line extending east approximately 8.5 miles to the Junction of US-271, US-59 and SH-9, in Leflore County;
6. US-70: Beginning at the Junction of US-70 and SH-93, in the City of Hugo, extending east 18.8 miles to the McCurtain County line;
7. SH-93: Beginning at the Junction of US-70 and SH-93, in the City of Hugo, extending north approximately 7.0 miles to Griffin Rd./Coker Rd./E2010Rd., in Choctaw County;
8. US-70: Beginning at the Choctaw County line extending east approximately 23.8 miles to the Junction of US-70, US-259 and SH-3, in the City of Idabel, in McCurtain County;
9. US-70 Bypass: Beginning at the Junction of US-70 and US-70 Bypass, in the City of Idabel, extending south and east approximately 4.3 miles to the Junction of US-259 and US-70 Bypass, in McCurtain County;
10. US-259: Beginning at the Junction of US-259 and US-70 Bypass, in the City of Idabel, extending east and north approximately 4.9 miles to the Junction of US-259, US-70 and SH-3, in McCurtain County;
11. US-259/US-70/SH-3: Beginning at the Junction of US-259, US-70 and SH-3, in the City of Idabel, extending north approximately 1.4 mile, in McCurtain County;

12. US-259/US-70/SH-3: Beginning approximately 2.7 miles north of the Junction of US-259, US-70 and SH-3, in the City of Idabel, extending north approximately 3.0 miles Craig Rd./E 2080 Rd., in the City of Broken Bow, in McCurtain County;
13. SH-3: Beginning approximately 0.5 mile east of the Junction of SH-93 and SH-3, in the Town of Rattan, extending east approximately 15.1 miles to the McCurtain County line, in Pushmataha County;
14. SH-3: Beginning at the Pushmataha County line extending east approximately 10.3 miles to approximately 0.8 mile east of N4555 Rd./Old SH-98, in McCurtain County;
15. SH-3: Beginning at the Junction of SH-98 and SH-3 extending southeast approximately 11.1 miles to the Junction of US-259, US-70 and SH-3, in the City of Broken Bow, in McCurtain County;
16. SH-120: Beginning at the Junction of SH-112 and SH-120 extending east approximately 3.0 miles to the Arkansas State line, in Leflore County;
17. US-271: Beginning at the Junction of US-271, SH-1 and SH-63, in the City of Talihina, extending northeast approximately 23.1 miles to the Junction of US-271 and US-270, in the Town of Caston, in Leflore County;
18. SH-112: Beginning approximately 0.8 mile northeast of the US-59, US-59 Bypass, US-271 and SH-112 interchange, in the City of Poteau, extending northeast approximately 16.1 miles to the Junction of US-271, SH-9 and SH-112, in the City of Pocola, in Leflore County;
19. US-271/SH-9/SH-112: Beginning at the Junction of US-271, SH-9 and SH-112, in the City of Pocola, extending east approximately 2.7 miles to the Arkansas State Line, in Leflore County.

The project is estimated to cost \$975,000.00

b) Oklahoma County – District IV

We have received a request from the Division IV Engineer for the installation of pavement markings on US-77(Broadway Ext.) beginning at approximately Wilshire Blvd., in the City of Oklahoma City, extending north approximately 3.8 miles to just north of the John Kilpatrick Turnpike interchange, in Oklahoma County - The project is estimated to cost \$326,000.00
