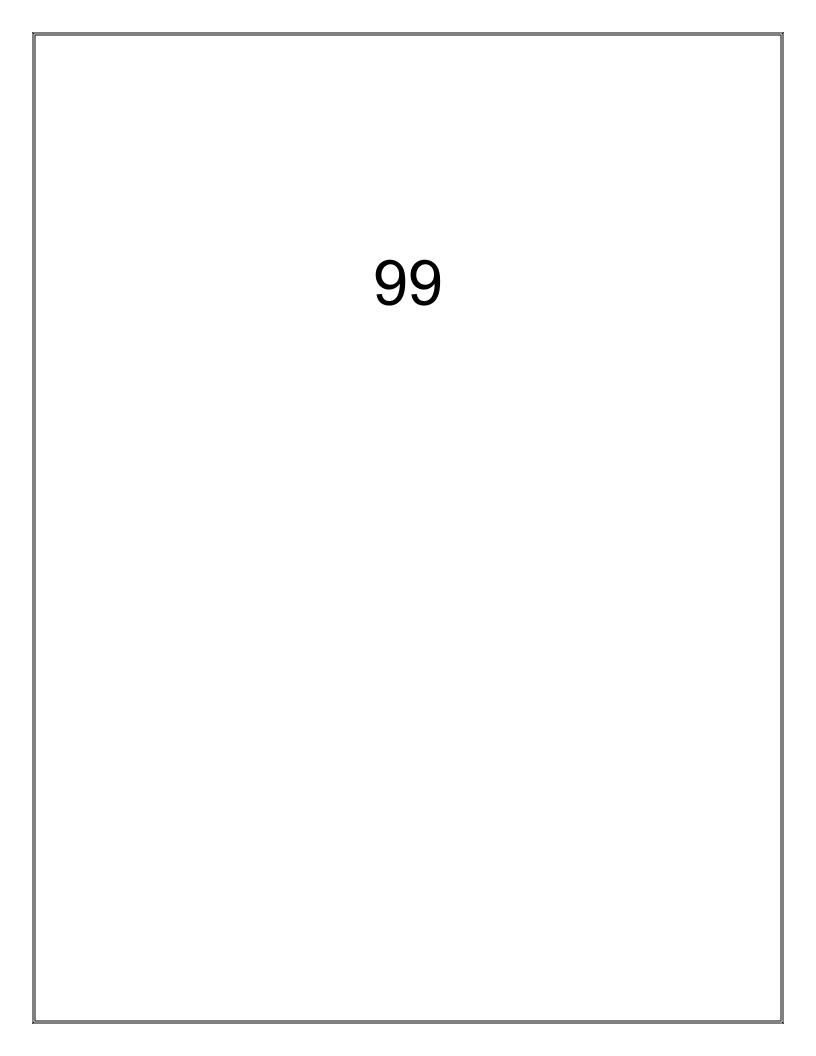

97. Director's Report – Information Only

Director Tim Gatz began his report by extending his congratulations to Jason Giebler on the State Bridge Engineer position, and Brandon Dudgeon on the Director of Project Management position.

Director Gatz thanked Chairwoman Nicole Miller for her attendance and recognized the job she does as chairwoman of the Transportation A and B Committee and Sub-Committee and has for a long time been an advocate for transportation, representing in the House of Representatives.

Gatz thanked the Commission for their approval on the County Improvements for Roads and Bridges Program (CIRB) and added the program is one of the Departments important interactions with county government and the plan has good investment opportunities on the county system and has become instrumental in helping the progress on the counties bridges and road systems.

ODOT celebrated the 25th year anniversary of the Heartland Flyer along with Amtrak with a sold-out train. Gatz thanked Jared Schwennesen, Director of Multimodal & Planning, and his team for their coordination with Amtrak.

Director Gatz began his project updates with a \$30 million resurface and shoulder addition in Cherokee and Sequoya counties on SH-82, on the east side of Lake Tenkiller, from Cookson North to Illinois River crossing. This project will also include reconfiguring driveways and intersections and will begin late fall of 2024 and will last a year and a half in duration. Gatz stated the project will likely impact the 2025 lake season and the Department will work to manage traffic to the best of its abilities.

The Department will start resurfacing I-40 near Shawnee in August 2024, beginning at US-177 east, approximately five miles into Shawnee. Optimistically, the project will be completed by Halloween and has night work incorporated into the contract but will have a major impact on traffic, as the project will take place on one of the busiest corridors in the State.

Gatz continued the project updates by discussing the \$40 million project that began July 1st on SH-152 in Canadian County from Union City extending east into Mustang about ten miles. The project will add shoulders, resurfacing and improving sight distance. This highway carries a significant amount of traffic between SH-81 and the Mustang Proper and will last through winter of 2025.

An example of the Department and the Contractor working together to create an aggressive work schedule to alleviate traffic issues on major corridors, is the I-235 bridge rehabilitation/joint replacement project. Biltrite Construction narrowed and shifted lanes while working on a 24/7 schedule and finished the project two months ahead of the original schedule. Director Gatz commended Biltrite for their progressive work and a job well done.

Gatz concluded the project updates with the final portion of the I-235 and I-44 work which includes the Lincoln Boulevard ramp to I-44, now closed for the final phase of that work. The project will give drivers an improved ramp from Lincoln Boulevard to I-44 and a direct lane onto the Broadway extension and will cost about \$16 million. This last phase of the interchange improvement has taken the Department more than twelve years to modernize.

The Department's safety campaign this month is pedestrian safety. Director Gatz reminded the traveling public to be aware of pedestrians at all times and to create safer walking environments, manage driving speeds and to put down distractions. Chances of a pedestrian surviving a crash, rapidly decreases when the vehicle speeds above 30 miles per hour. Drivers should stay vigilant near schools, parks, shopping areas, transit stops, sidewalks and move over when pedestrians are on the sides of the highways. About 75% of pedestrians are killed in traffic crashes after dark.

Director Gatz acknowledged Independence Day and the probability of traffic increases and reminded the traveling public to buckle up and stay safe during the Holiday.

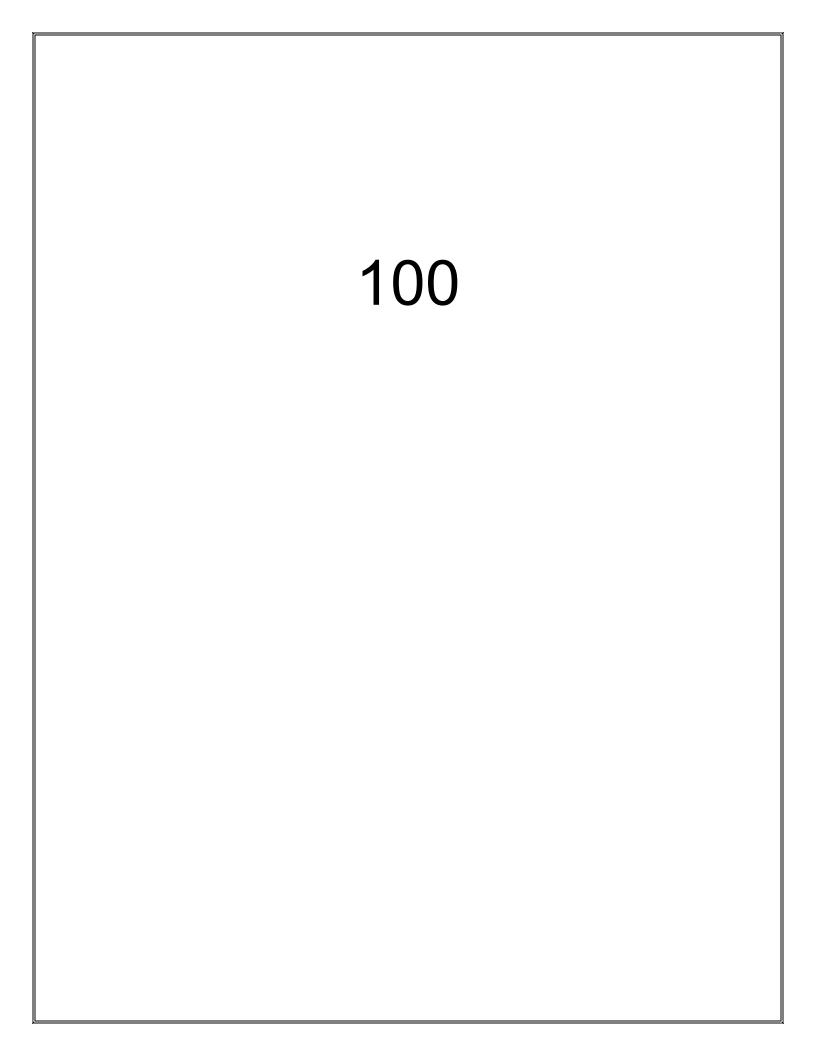

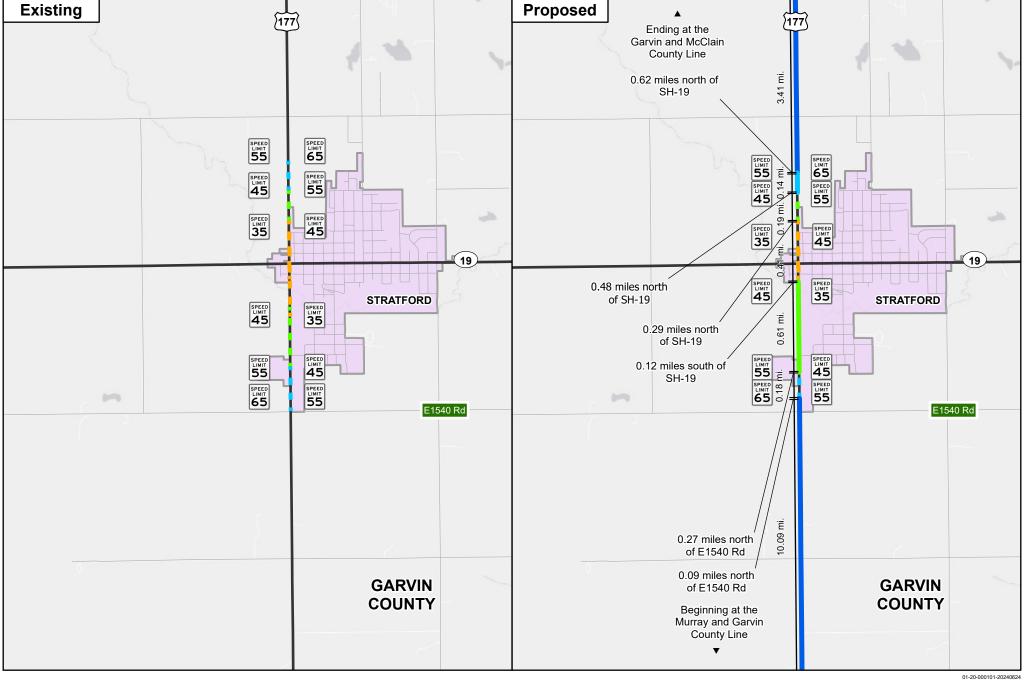

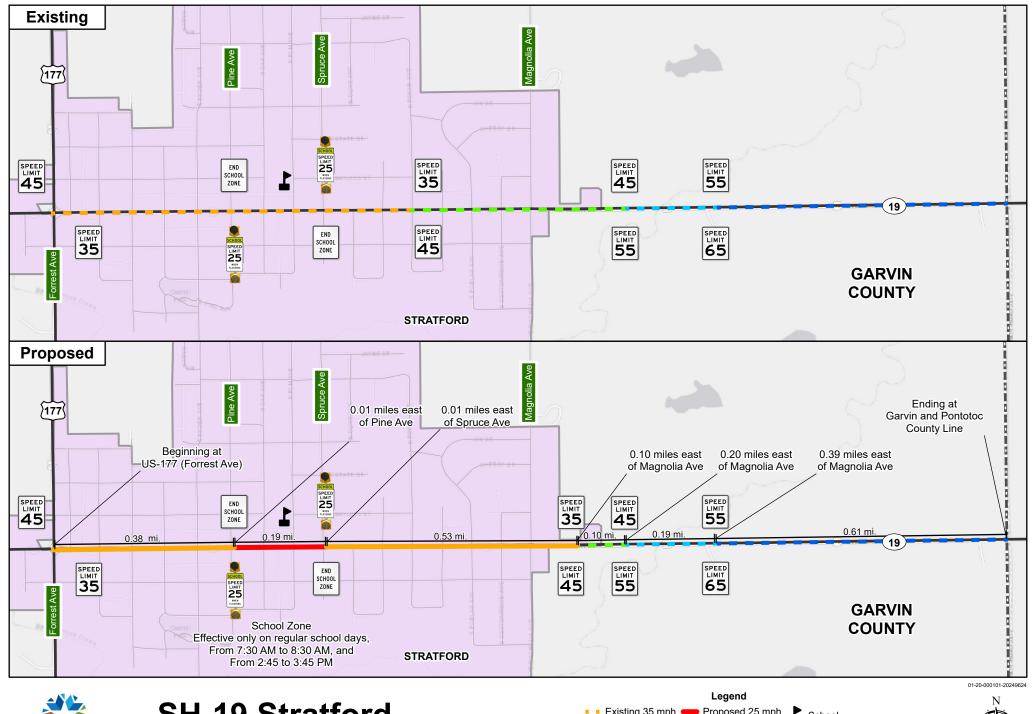
US-177 Stratford Speed Zone Revision

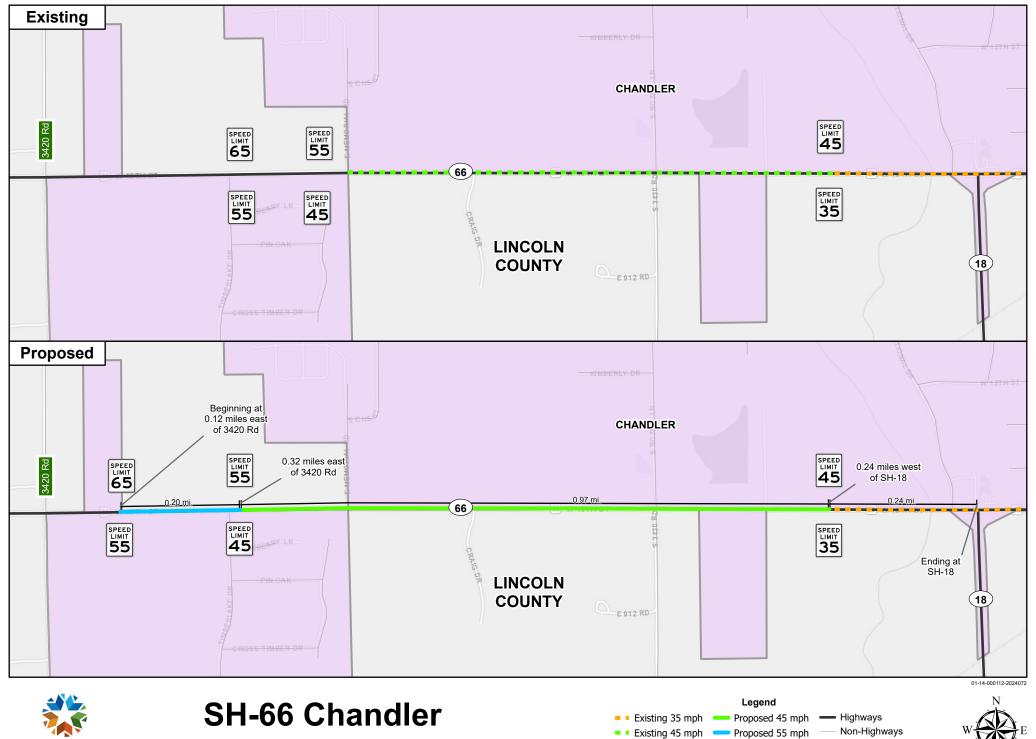




SH-19 Stratford Speed Zone Revision



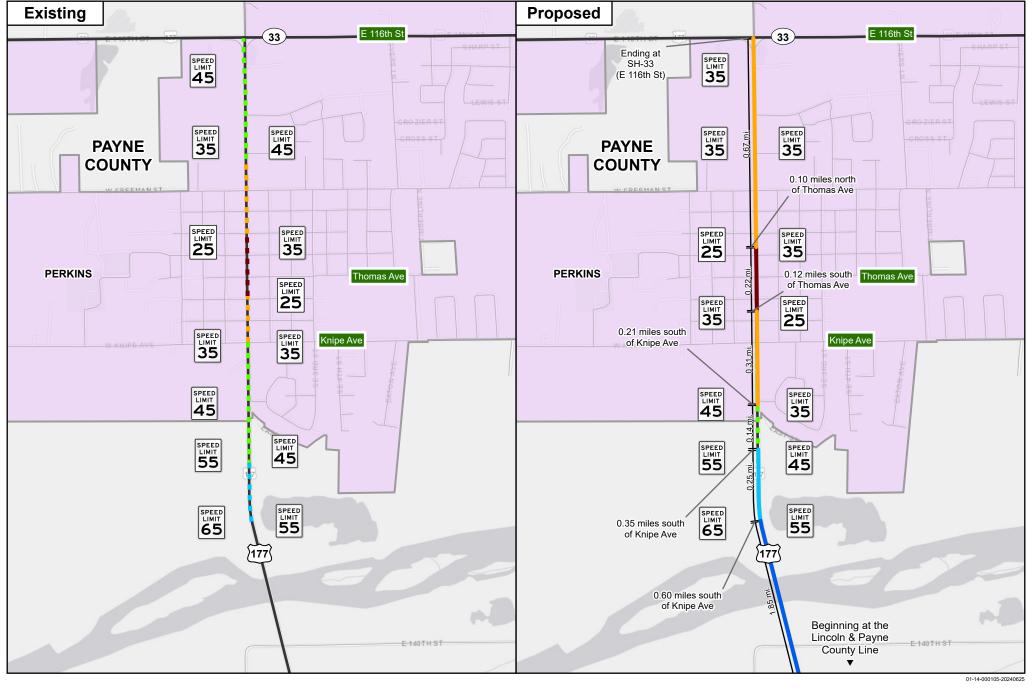

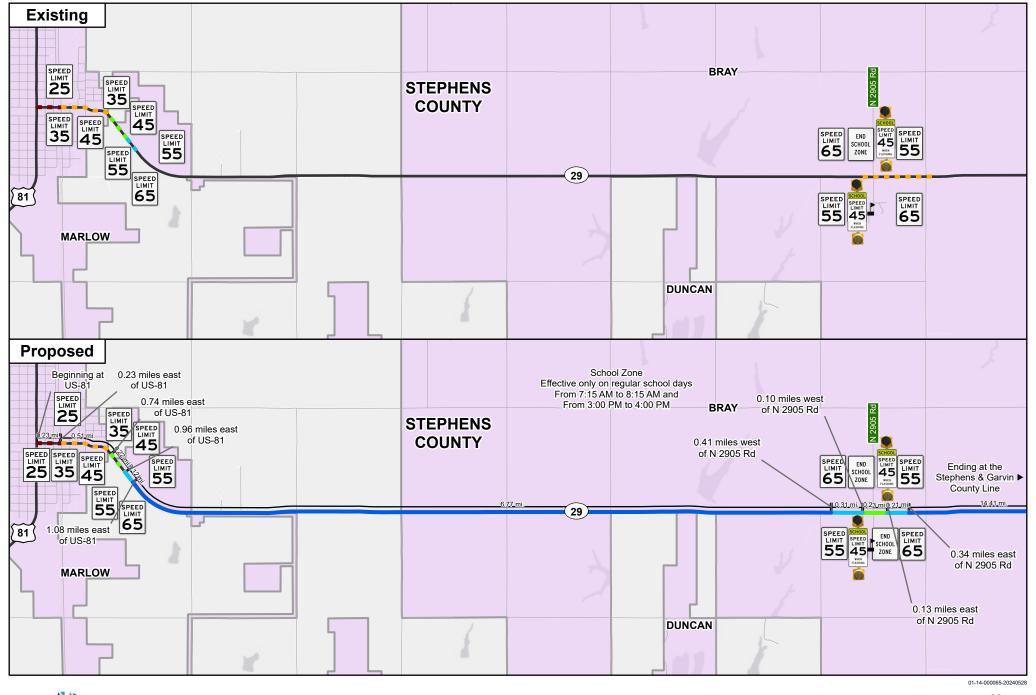

SUBJECT: Designation of Memorial Highways & Bridges per 2024 Legislation

LOCATION: Statewide

With respect to the provisions of Title 69 O.S. 2024 Sections 1600 et seq. the Department requests the Commission's approval for certain memorial designations and sign installations as directed in Senate Bill 1803, along with House Bills 3516 & 2291. In accordance with these measures, approved during the 2024 legislative session with an effective date of November 1, 2024, the Department seeks Commission approval for the following designations and amendments.

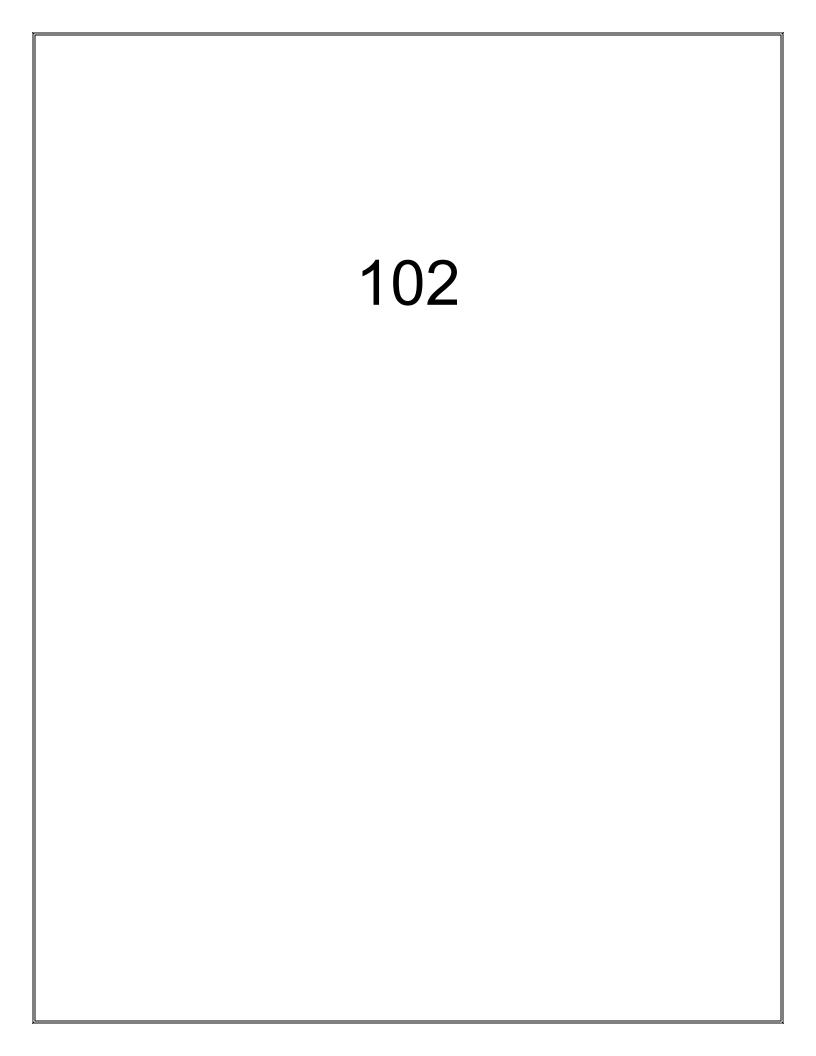

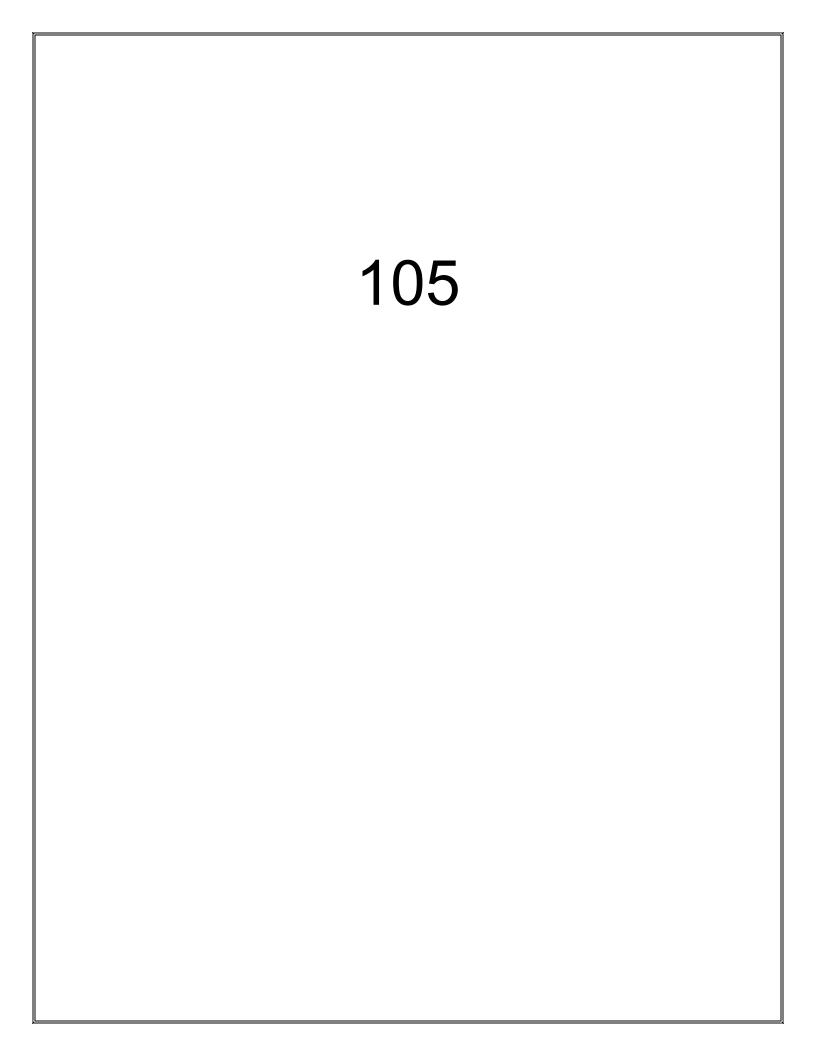

Change Order No. 4 approves a supplemental agreement and an additional appropriation in the amount of \$31,220.92.

Engineering: This change provides payment for the overrun of the approach slab, Class A concrete, and Class AA concrete pay items required to construct the bridge as specified due to an underestimation of the contract amounts; for the slope wall and special concrete finish pay items required to complete the project as specified due to these items being omitted from the plans; for the handrailing pay item required to remove and replace the existing handrailing to accommodate construction of the new bridge; for the irrigation pay item required to repair the existing irrigation system in the median of Robinson Street after being damaged during construction due to not being identified in the plans; for the traffic items pay item required to provide traffic control during nighttime lane closures for bridge painting. This change applies a deduction to the special inlet drain pay item due to not installing the decorative stone specified to be placed around each inlet for fear of it eroding into the inlet. This change documents the underrun of the reinforcing steel pay items due to an overestimation of the contract amounts.

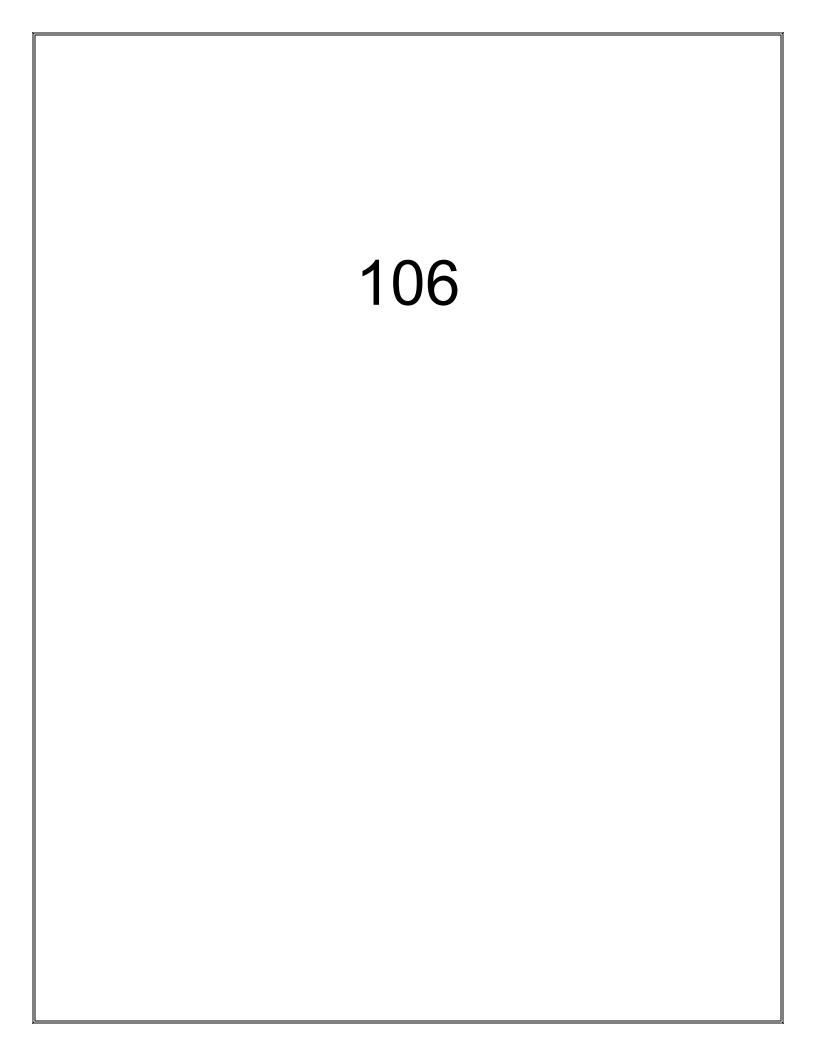

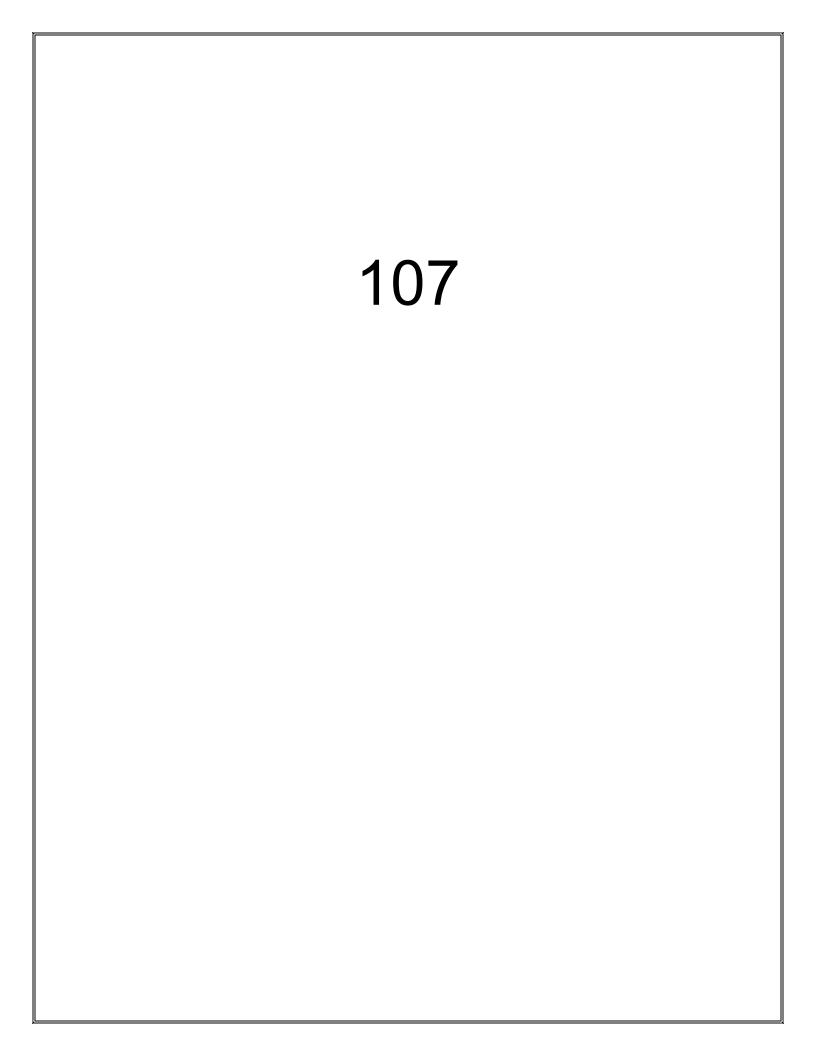
