Commencing at the NE corner of said N'_2 NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, thence S 89°31'08" W along the North line of said N'_2 NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ a distance of 91.30 feet to a point on the present West right-of-way line of State Highway No. 102, said point being the point of beginning, thence continuing S 89°31'08" W along said North line a distance of 568.49 feet to the NW corner of said N'_2 NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, thence S 00°27'44" E along the West line of said N'_2 NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, thence N 89°32'04" E along the South line of said N'_2 NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ a distance of 569.31 feet to a point on the present West right-of-way line of State Highway No. 102, thence N 00°36'17" W along said right-of-way line a distance of 329.31 feet to said Point of Beginning.
