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Pursuant to Title 69 Oklahoma Statutes (2021), Section 1001, the Oklahoma Department of Transportation offers the following property for sale by sealed bid to the highest bidder. Bid proposals sent by REGISTERED MAIL will be received through the Oklahoma Department of Transportation, Facilities Management Division on May 12, 2022 until 1:00 PM CST. Hand Delivered bids will be received at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation Building, Facilities Management Division, 200 N.E. 21st Street, Room 1-B7, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 on May 12, 2022 until 1:30 PM CST. The bids will be opened and immediately read publicly on May 12, 2022 at 1:30 PM CST. in the ODOT Project Management Conference Room located at the address above.

Description of Property:

A strip, piece or parcel of land lying in part of River Lot 1 and part of River Lot 2 (part of the NW/4) of Section 12, T18N, R17W, in Dewey County, Oklahoma. Said parcel of land being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the NW corner of said Lot 1; thence East along the North line of said Lot 1 a distance of 57.00 feet to a point on the permanent West right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 183; thence S42°47'00"E along permanent West right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 183 a distance of 193.16; thence Southeasterly along permanent West right-of-way line of U.S. Highway No. 183 on a curve to the Left with a Radius of 2009.83 feet and a length of 686.99 feet (Chord Bearing - S32°16'29"E and Chord Length - 683.65 feet) to a point on the Northerly right-of-way line of a County Road; thence S47°08'00"W along the Northerly right-of-way line of County Road a distance of 776.29 feet to a point on the West line of Lot 2; thence North along the West line of said Lots 2 & 1 a distance of 1241.70 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**.

Containing 8.39 acres, more or less.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation has set the **minimum bid** requirement at \$18,941.00 for this sale. The parcel is being sold "as is-where is", with the buyer being responsible for their own due diligence in regards to zoning, licenses, permits, environmental, land uses, etc.

Terms of the sale are ten percent (10%) of the bid price in **non-refundable certified funds** and must accompany each bid in the form of a bid deposit made payable to the "Oklahoma Department of Transportation." The balance of the successful high bid will be due in certified funds within thirty (30) calendar days after the approval by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission, and all **deposits submitted by non-successful bidders will be returned said approval.** The successful high bidder will also be required to pay for any and all advertising costs associated with the sale of this land. After approval of the sale, an executed and recorded Quitclaim Deed will be mailed to the highest bidder. IMPORTANT: LABEL THE OUTSIDE OF THE ENVELOPE WITH "SEALED BID".

All sales of surplus lands, or interests therein, is subject to the confirmation of the Oklahoma Transportation Commission. The Oklahoma Transportation Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
