I am pleased to submit this letter in support of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation's (ODOT's) application for a Bridge Improvement Program grant (BIP) to continue critically needed improvements to the bridges on the I-40 over Portland and I-44 'K' Interchange in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
