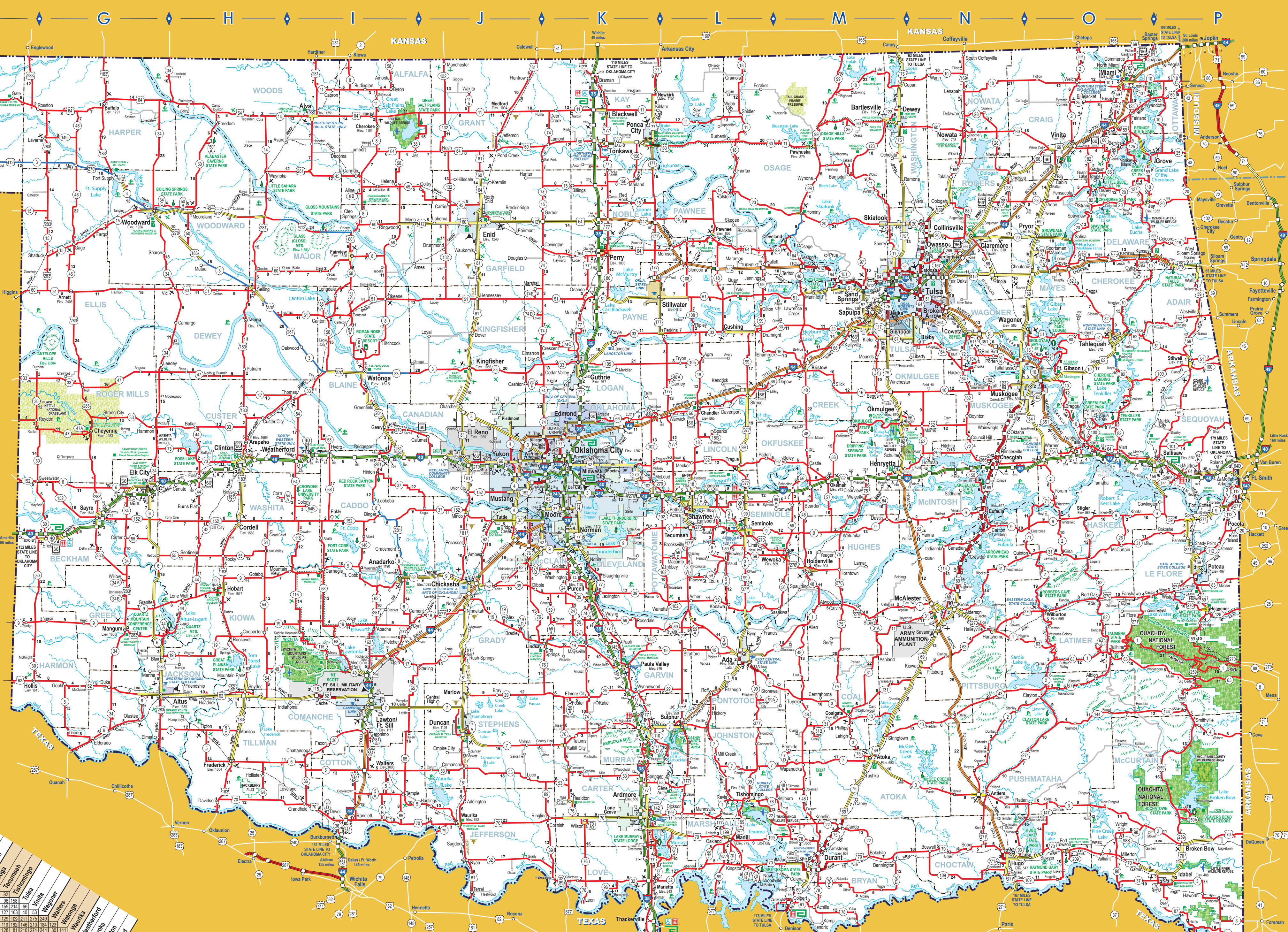
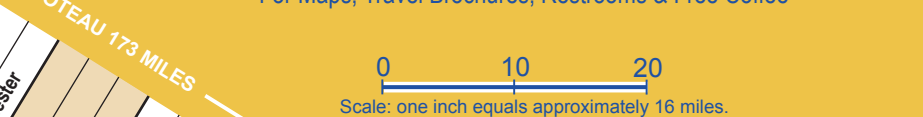

### the famous chisholm trail turns 150

America's most illustrious cattle trail celebrates its 150th anniversary in 2017. Established by Jesse Chisholm, a half-Cherokee cattleman from Tennessee, the trail's boundaries have long been in dispute. But all historians agree the trail was used to drive cattle from Texas through present-day Oklahoma to the Kansas Pacific Railway in Abilene, Kansas.

From there, cattle were shipped to the American North and East, where they fetched ten times the market price in Texas. Today, the trail is dotted with museums, memorials and interactive exhibits where visitors can travel back in time. ### capitol celebrates 100

One hundred years ago, the Oklahoma state Capitol was dedicated and quickly became a beacon for many cultures around the world. On June 30th, 1907, the building was completed, however, the intended dome was omitted due to funding. In November 2008, the state celebrated the dedication of the long awaited dome and its crowning element - a 22-ft. tall bronze sculpture called The Guardian created by Native American artist and former State Senator Enoch Kelly Haney.
