The existing SH-123 Bridge over the Caney River (built in 1937) within Johnstone Park (protected resource area) is a 3-span truss bridge with sidewalks, is in poor condition, is structurally deficient, and is currently posted with a 10-ton load limit. This bridge and the dam under the bridge are eligible for listing on National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). The purpose of the project is to provide a structurally sound crossing and preserve the transportation continuity over the Caney River on SH-123.
