## PROJECT

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is improving a segment of SH-66 between Depew and Bristow in Creek County. This segment begins approximately 1.5 miles east of Depew, Oklahoma at the intersection of SH-66 and S. 433rd W. Avenue and extends east approximately 4.2 miles to the intersection of SH-66 and S. 369th W. Avenue in Bristow, Oklahoma (see Location Map on reverse). The existing highway through this extent has inadequate shoulders, sharp curves, and steep hills, which result in limited sight distance and unsafe conditions.

## PURPOSE

The purpose of the project is to improve the safety of a segment of roadway with no shoulders and correct unsafe curves and intersections.

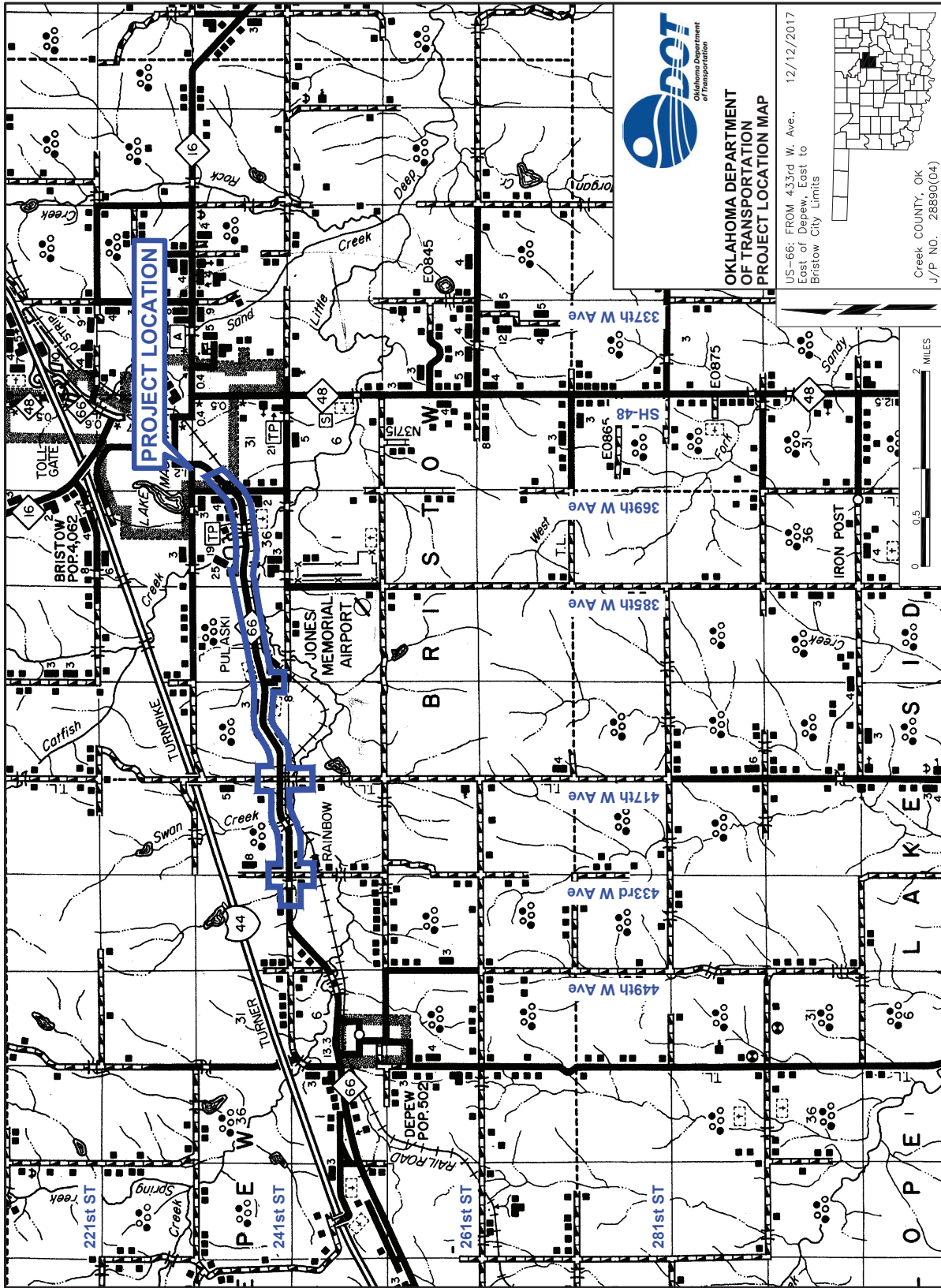

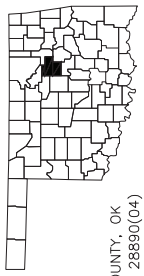
