Purpose of Meeting

To present the proposed improvements and to answer questions and receive public comments regarding the construction sequence.

Project Background

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) is proposing to improve US-385 at the Boise City Square around the Cimarron County Courthouse and Cimarron Ave to the north for 0.7 miles in Boise City, OK.



Project Description

The project will correct deficiencies in the roadway and pavement, resolve drainage problems, provide parking, ensure proper turning movements for large vehicles, and define pedestrian access to the county courthouse (inner square). The completed project will provide for circular traffic movement for vehicles traversing the Boise City Square. The outer corners of the square will provide parking areas with some added protection during backing movements. The circular pattern and parking areas will include islands, patterned concrete, and pedestrian crosswalks. Walkways are provided throughout the square to ensure pedestrian safety.

The project is currently schedule to let for construction in July 2019. Total construction time is estimated to be 270 days. During this construction period, US-385 and SH-3 extending north from the Boise City Square will be closed for approximately 180 working days. Business access will be provided at all times with the use of temporary drives. Detours will be set up during this time.
