Two ways to meet 5 Star:

- 1) Meet all 2, 3, 4, and 5 Star criteria OR
- 2) Have a permit or license, meet minimum licensing requirements & 4 Star criteria described below PLUS
 - a) Accredited OR
 - b) Head Start

When you choose to meet by #1 above: meet all items listed in 2 & 3 & 4 Star FCCH Overview plus all of the 5 Star items below.

Learning Environment

- Two enhancement activities are regularly carried out, such as:
 - o indoor or outdoor interest areas
 - o additional inviting, hands-on, open-ended learning experiences
 - o onsite dance, gymnastics, or sports lessons (etc.)
 - o additional health and wellness activities
 - see Indicator/Evidence chart for additional options

Additional 5 Star Criteria

- FCCHs do 2 additional professional development criteria from the following list:
 - The primary caregiver maintains a PDL Level 5 or above.
 - o The primary caregiver does 30 hours of training a year.
 - o The primary caregiver takes Family Child Care Home Leadership Academy.
 - o The assistant caregiver gets 30 hours of training a year.
 - The FCCH uses ongoing evidence-based coaching.
 - The primary caregiver completes Pyramid Model Infant/Toddler, Preschool, or Birth to Five Modules.
- FCCHs do both formal parent orientations and formal child orientations. (Accredited FCCHs do not need to do this criteria.)
- FCCHs do 4 additional program criteria from the following list (Accredited FCCHs do not need to do this criteria.):
 - o Developmental child screenings or assessments
 - Use a health consultant
 - Daily playground safety checklists
 - Annual staff emergency plan and procedure training
 - Participate in federal food program
 - Gets quality initiative certifications
 - Works with schools regarding children's health & wellness
