**Q:** What is the admission process at OSB?

**Q:** How much does it cost to send a student to OSB?

**A:** There is no cost to the families of OSB students. OSB is tuition free.

**Q:** Does OSB provide transportation for my student?

**A:** OSB provides transportation for residential students to designated locations throughout the state.

**Q:** Can my child live on campus at OSB?

**A:** A residential program is open when school is in session. Students reside at their homes on weekends, major holidays and school closings. Older students may qualify for a 4 to 6 week rotation in Lowery Hall, our on-campus independent living apartments.

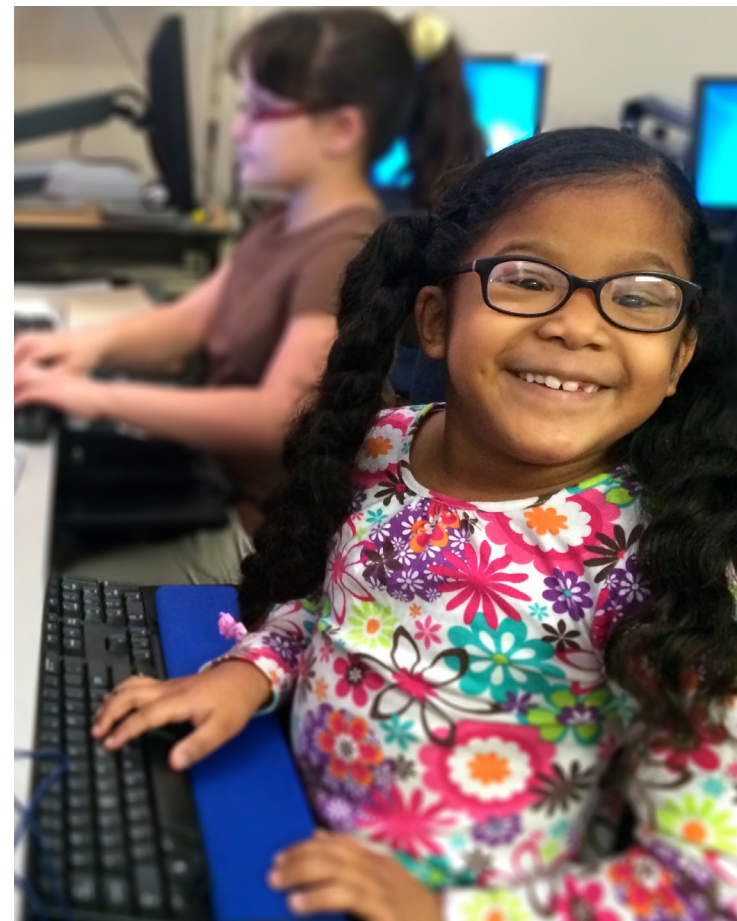

# outreach services

OSB also serves as a resource for all 77 counties in Oklahoma. Services are available to any visually impaired/ blind student 21 years of age and younger.

- Outreach services include consultation, curriculum assistance, classroom modifications and assistance with technical equipment.
- Students receive free evaluations on academic achievement, orientation and mobility, low vision, psychological profiles and living skills.
- Early intervention services are provided for children ages birth to 3 years.
