

2022 PCMH Redesign Q&A Behavioral Health Screening & Mock Audit Opportunity

WEBINAR #1 - May 12, 2022:

1. Is this guidance for all mental health patient screening?

This information contains best practices for medical home providers to meet the patient-centered medical home behavioral health screening requirement of screening all members assigned to the panel that are age 5 and older.

2. Do you need to already be a medical home provider?

Yes, in order to qualify for the behavioral health screening incentive or to participate in a mock audit, the provider must have a SoonerCare Choice patient-centered medical home contract.

3. Will there be a list of what you will be looking for when auditing? Audits of the behavioral health screening requirement will be looking for an approved and completed screening tool with results contained within the medical record with a date that corresponds to the billing of 96160.

WEBINAR #2 - May 19, 2022:

1. Do behavioral health screenings need to be billed using modifiers? PCMH providers billing 96160 with an E/M code are required to append modifier 25 to the E/M code. Please see <u>National Correct Coding Initiative</u> (oklahoma.gov) for more guidance on NCCI.
