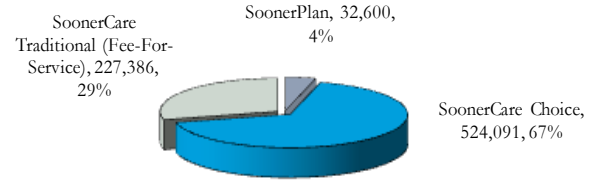

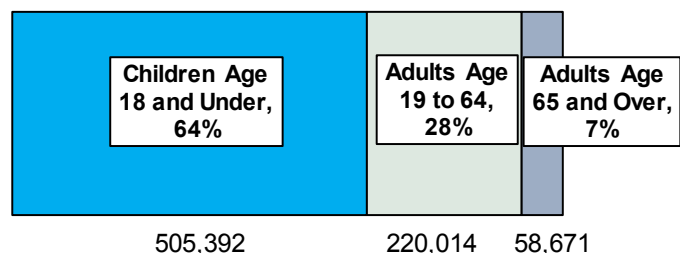

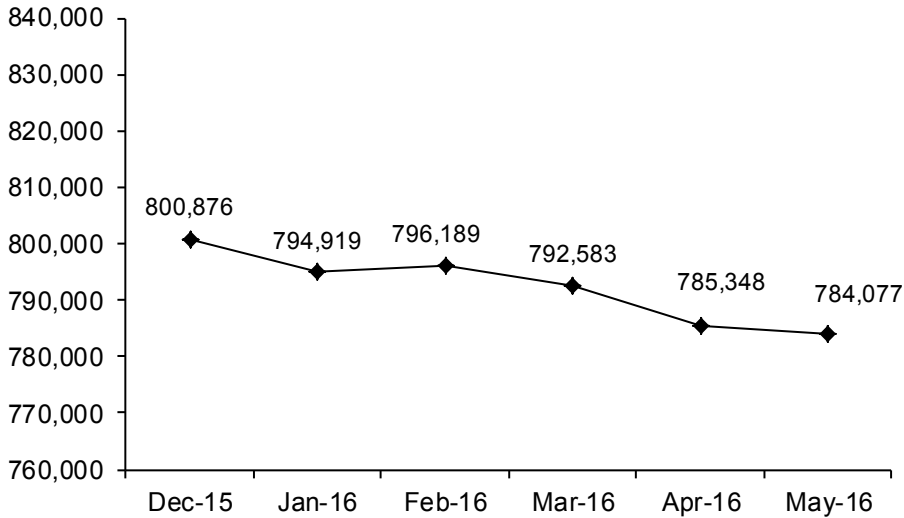
### Age Breakdown of Total Enrollment



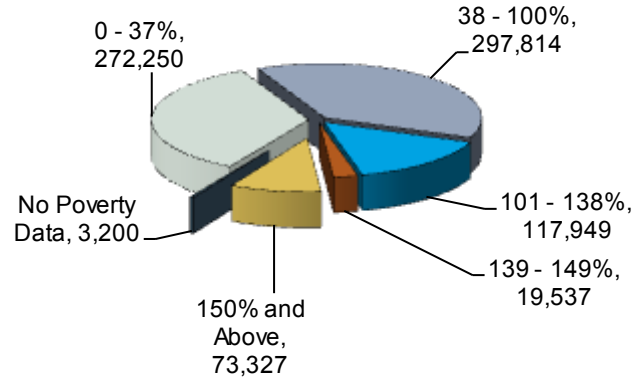
