Dear Pharmacy Provider,

<u>Effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005</u> Atacand, Atacand HCT, Concerta, Focalin, Focalin XR, and Wellbutrin XL will move to Tier 1 and will no longer require a prior authorization as the manufacturers have entered into a supplemental rebate agreement. All ARBS now Tier 1.

<u>Effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005</u> SSNRIs (Selective Serotonin Norepinephrine Reuptake Inhibitors) will be added to step therapy. See chart below.

<u>Effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2005</u> Advicor, Pravachol, Celexa and Lexxel will no longer be on Tier 1 and will now require a prior authorization or a previous trial on a Tier 1 medication.

Step therapy's goal is to optimize each client's medical therapy with medication that best treats the client's condition given their unique health status and circumstances. Tier 1 medications are preferred as the first step for treating a client's health condition. They are cost effective and are available without prior authorization from OHCA.

Providers who have clients with clinical exceptions may request a prior authorization to skip the step therapy process and receive the Tier 2 drug immediately. Prior authorization forms can be found on the OHCA website at:

Clients who have been on a Tier 2 drug within specified days of date of service will be "grandfathered." This allows a client to continue on a Tier 2 drug without a trial on a Tier 1 drug.
