**SUBJECT: Emergency Compounding for Tamiflu**

## Emergency Compounding of an Oral Suspension from Tamiflu® 75 mg Capsules

Commercially manufactured Tamiflu® for Oral Suspension (12 mg/mL) is the preferred product for pediatric and adult patients who have difficulty swallowing capsules or where lower doses are needed. In the event that Tamiflu® for Oral Suspension is not available, the FDA has given approval for pharmacists to compound a suspension (15 mg/mL) from Tamiflu® 75 mg Capsules using Ora-Sweet® Sugar-Free or Humco® Cherry Syrup. Other vehicles have not been studied. This compounded suspension should not be used for convenience or when the FDA-approved Tamiflu® for Oral Suspension is available.

- SoonerCare does not cover Humco® Cherry Syrup due to federal drug rebate requirements.

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The approved compounding procedure is included in the professional prescribing information and results in a 15 mg/mL suspension. *Healthcare providers should note that the compounded suspension is a different concentration than commercially available Tamiflu® for Oral Suspension,* which has a concentration of 12 mg/mL. Pharmacists and health care providers should ensure that an appropriate dispensing device (i.e., one that measures volume in mL) is provided with the compounded suspension of Tamiflu®.
