PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to C.F.R. § 447.205, the Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) is required to give public notice of any significant proposed change in methods and standards for setting payment rates for services in the SoonerCare program. The following payment changes will necessitate amendments to the Oklahoma Medicaid State Plan.

Nursing Facilities Supplemental Payment Program

The OHCA proposes to implement a supplemental payment program for nursing facilities owned, and as applicable, operated by non-state government owned (NSGO) entities effective May 1, 2018. The state plan amendment defines the scope, the payment methodology, and the payment frequency for the supplemental payment program up to the allowable Medicare upper payment limit (UPL) to qualified NSGOs. The estimated total federal budget impact for the Nursing Facilities Supplemental Payment Program State Plan Amendment is \$7,737,891 for the remainder of federal fiscal year (FFY) 2018 and \$18,570,938 for federal fiscal year (FFY) 2019. Additional federal dollars will be available by leveraging the gap between Medicaid and Medicare payments up to the UPL. It is estimated that this request will be budget neutral for the State as the NSGOs will bear the cost of providing the state share match for the program.
