Re: Emergency Rulemaking pursuant to HB 1146, Civil Service and Human Capital Modernization Act

Human Capital Management of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services promulgated emergency rules pursuant to HB 1146, the Civil Service and Human Capital Modernization Act, which is effective Jan. 1, 2022. The emergency rules can be found at Title 260, Chapter 130.

The new law and rules will result in changes for several Human Resources functions, including categorizing jobs and increased flexibility in hiring and compensating employees. For employees, it also brings changes to their rights to appeal personnel actions. OMES created <a href="these-FAQs">these-FAQs</a> and this <a href="mailto:one-page">one-page</a> overview regarding the rule changes.

The appeals process for adverse employment actions will change significantly. As a reference on the overall process for these complaints, OMES has provided this flowchart.

As referenced in Civil Service and Human Capital Modernization Rule 260:130-27-5, the Civil Service Division established a standard of progressive discipline.

Please note the same rules will also follow the permanent rulemaking process. The comment period will be set forth in the Notice of Rulemaking Intent for Title 260, Chapter 130 and will run until Jan. 20, 2022. The public hearing on the rules in Title 260, Chapter 130 will be on Jan. 20, 2022, from 9:30 a.m. until noon at the ODOT Training Facility located at 5307 N.E. 122nd St, Oklahoma City, OK 73131.
