Qualifying Criteria for Obtaining Title on a Vintage Vehicle

Vintage Vehicle means a passenger automobile or truck having no more than two axles and for which no Oklahoma certificate of title exists in the records of Service Oklahoma prior to January 1, 1980, and which has not been registered in the records of Service Oklahoma or any other state for a period of fifteen (15) or more years prior to the date as of which the application for certificate of title is made.

The vintage vehicle may not be subject to a lien by any person or other legal entity for the purchase price of the vehicle, for expenses associated with repair or refurbishment of the vehicle, storage charges or any other purpose.

A person or other legal entity may register a vintage vehicle and obtain an Oklahoma certification of title for the vehicle upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) and providing a verified statement, under oath, submitted to Service Oklahoma for review.

Upon review of the information contained in the application for a certificate of title, Service Oklahoma shall determine whether or not the title may be issued.

If a vintage vehicle certificate of title is issued, the person or other legal entity making application shall pay excise and sales tax. The vehicle shall be subject to the annual registration requirements as provided by law for other motor vehicles.
